The Solution

- buy out private power companies;

- create an independent Power Corporation that will guarantee freedom from political control, interference or patronage;
- ensure that sufficient reserves of power will be available to all parts of Alberta at the lowest possible rates for domestic, agricultural and industrial uses;
- guarantee no interference with any existing municipally-owned public power system;
- guarantee security of present employees of power companies in every respect;
- operate Alberta's power resources on sound business principles.

The Solution - Cont'd

- purchase Rural Electrification distribution systems
 if they want to sell;
- establish a Department of Water Resources
 to guarantee conservation and control of river
 water for domestic, agricultural and industrial
 purposes;
- s commence action on approved dams and diversion projects.

OIL AND GAS

A Liberal Government Will ...

- authorize the sale of Alberta's natural gas to Alberta industrial and residential consumers at lower rates than those charged to purchasers outside Alberta, therby enabling lower cost domestic gas rates for Alberta residents and fostering industry in Alberta;

- provide at least one annual sale of corwn oil and gas rights, on a highest royalty instead of a cash bonus basis.
