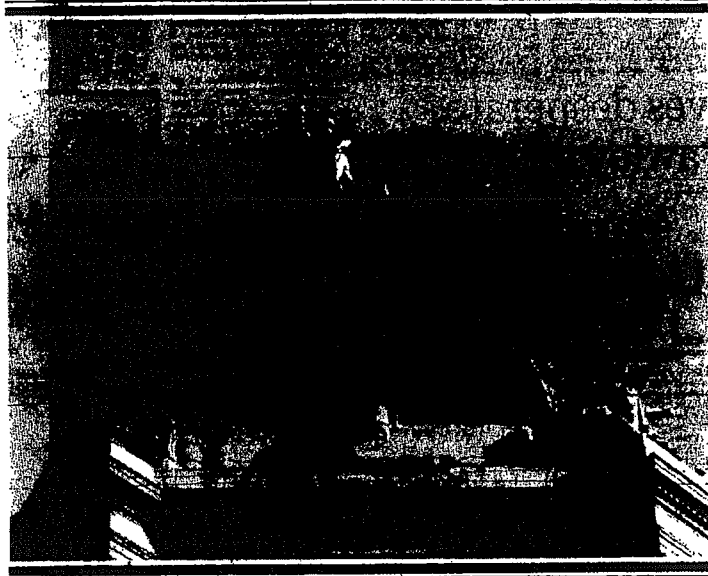


How can you make sure Manitoba's next government is sensible, humane and responsible?

Safe Neighbourhoods — Inner city residents are being held hostage in their own homes by a rising wave of violent crime. We must provide the funding

to put policemen back on the beat. Only the Liberal party is committed to that responsibility.

The Kind of Quality Education We Used to Have — The Tories have allowed our education system to slip disgracefully. In 1977, the province paid 36% of university operating costs. By 1981, that share had plummeted to a shocking 18%. The Liberal watchdogs in our new legislature would force a Conservative government to live up to its responsibility to provide quality education.

Mega Projects That Create Jobs, Not Public Debt — The Liberal position on mega projects is clear: jobs YES, giveaways NO. Manitobans are being asked to buy a pig in a poke. Both the Conservatives and NDP are responsible for a series of fiascos. Remember CFI? Modern Fine Foods? Saunders Aircraft? Lauchlan and his Liberals are your guarantee that the next government of Manitoba will be responsible. NOT to big unions. NOT to big business. but to YOU the taxpayer.

Fiscal Responsibility — Manitoba's public debt has increased a billion dollars under the Lyon conservatives. And the NDP are running an expensive "promise-a-day" campaign. The Liberals will help save Manitoba from bankruptcy.
