Why do we need a  
NEW LABRADOR PARTY ?

- (1) To establish an identity for Labrador so that our problems do not become lost and ignored among all the rest of the Province's problems.
- (2) To put a three-man team in the House of Assembly who, together, will work for the common good of all three districts and speak as one voice representing all the people of Labrador.
- (3) To permit our Members in the House of Assembly to speak out on matters which affect Labrador in a way they cannot do as Liberals or P.C.s who are allowed to say only what will do the Party the most good.
- (4) To pave the way for the time when our increasing population will permit us to have our own Member of Parliament in the House of Commons in Ottawa, and to make sure the representation we then get is in the best interest of all Labradorians.
- (5) To work closely with all agencies concerned with Labrador in order to see that the most benefit comes out of government programs, and that any development plans which are going to affect Labrador are designed to assist the people of the area.
- (6) To act as a watchdog to see that any revenue derived from Labrador's resources are shared in such a way that Labrador gets its fair portion.
- (7) To create a better understanding among our own people in the three Labrador districts, and between Labradorians and those who live on the Island part of our Province.
