

Housing starts

- 47,000 new units far shead of all other pro-
- Alberts now contributes to over 21% of rotal states in Canada.

Improved social programs.

- Over 258,000 new jobs have been created for Albertans since 1971.— that's almost equal to all the jobs in either Edmonton or Calgary.
- Training and Apprenticeship programs give young Albertans the opportunity to learn a skill or trade . . . 25,000 new apprentices during the last four years.

Family income

· Since 1971 Albertans have come from third place to first in average family income.

Farms

- Net farm income in Alberta Agricultural more than tripled since 1971.
