

A Healthy Environment Ensures A Healthy Population

Quality life for all and a healthy environment are two basic green principles. A healthy economy that takes care of people's needs is the outcome of a healthy environment. The Greens have the courage and the vision to change things.

Here are some policies the Greens support:

Economy

- Self sufficient regional economies centred upon local ownership and operation of businesses
- Support for small scale community based projects using appropriate technologies
- Support for re-investing a portion of profits into the local economy
- Reduction of raw materials export and increase in value-added goods production
- Price of products to include environmental, social and economic costs.
- Job creation in environmental restoration, conservation and recycling
- Support for low-cost housing alternatives

Education and Health Care

- Restructuring of the present school board structure to redirect monies saved to the classroom level
- Equal per student funding rate with extra funding for special needs
- Consolidation of delivery of all social programs in regional community centres
- · Equal access to health care services for all
- Emphasis on prevention of illness and personal responsibility
- Honest presentations of treatment alternatives and consequences to patients
- Decentralized health care service with local accountability and community participation

Environment

- Reinstatement/enforcement of the regulations of the Alberta Environment Act and rejection of the more limited guidelines of the Clean Air and Clean Water Acts
- Ecological Impact Assessments Review Panels for all large projects with approval or rejection power
- Reduction of urban air pollution by encouraging public transportation and alternate energy sources
- Introduction of policies to protect animals and plants in the wild, and genetic diversity
- Initiatives to end the production of all ozone-depleting chemicals.
- Establishment of a Whistle-Blower Protection Act
- Strict regulations of all effluent producing industries and of costs of water purification
- Environmental impact charge on goods and services to fund waste elimination
- Costs of disposal, return or reuse of products to be the responsibility of producers
