# B.C. Socreds to Seek Company Unions' End

Provincial platform of B.C. Social Credit League advocates drafting of a new labor code under which company unions would be outlawed and equal pay for equal work would be mandatory.

The platform also includes these planks:

Return of provincial rights surrendered to the Federal Government under the 1947 agreement;

A "pay as you go" policy in all province affairs;

Abolition of B.C. Vegetable Marketing Board, adequate draining and flood control measures for farms;

Increased royalties on exploitation and development of natural resources and a program of reforestation;

All public and high school books to be supplied, increased educational grants to municipalities;

Repeal of compulsory hospital insurance and free public ward treatment for all to be paid from general revenue;

Increased old age pensions with Federal Government assuming full responsibility;

Replacing of the "pink slip" car insurance law by increasing licence fee \$1, and immediate completion of a Trans-Canada highway.
