





TO 28 DIFFERENT FISHERY COMPANIES AND 542 FISHERMEN AND SMALL FISHERY CONCERNS.

These loans helped to get 48 new Long-Liners, 10 new Draggers, 44 new combined Trap-Long-Liners, 92 used Fishing Boats, 342 new Engines, and several small Fish Plants.

### SOME FRUITS OF LIBERAL RULE

MINE PRODUCTION. Since the Smallwood Liberal Government came in power, more and more new mines have started up. In this present year the value of all the minerals produced will be ONE HUNDRED MILLION dollars (\$100,000,000). Last year it was \$92,681,000. In the past 13 years it has been \$844,392,000. More than three-quarters of a BILLION dollars!

**WATER POWER.** There has been a vast increase of electricity produced in this Province. There are tens of thousands more people enjoying the blessing of electric light than before the Smallwood Government came in. And this is only the beginning!

**CONSTRUCTION.** At least FIVE HUNDRED MILLION dollars worth of construction has gone ahead in the past 13 years—thousands of new homes, hundreds of new buildings for factories, mills, mines, rajlways, shops, churches, schools, hospitals.

**FARMING.** Thousands of acres of land have been newly cleared. Hundreds of thousands of dollars have been spent to help farmers stock up. The poultry industry is now at least TEN TIMES as large as it was 13 years ago. The mink industry has grown very fast.

OIL REFINING. Newfoundland now has her own oil refinery. Many new oil companies are now operating in Newfoundland, employing or otherwise giving a living to thousands of Newfoundlanders.

**NEW INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS.** Newfoundland is now producing many industrial products never made before the Smallwood Government came in power. Some of them: Cement, Gypsum board, hardwood flooring, plywood, Fibrply, Pyrophylite (Talc), Birch Spoolwood, Pre-stressed Concrete, Shirts, Movies.

**TB FREE AREA.** The Smallwood Government have made the Avalon Peninsula free of Bovine Tuberculosis. Many lives have thereby been saved.

BOG CLEARING. The new bog-clearing policy has been very successful, and already some thousands of acres of land have been completed. This work has attracted favourable attention in many parts of Canada.

**TOURIST ESTABLISHMENTS.** Under the Liberal policy many hundreds of new rooms have been provided in hotels, motels, cabins and other tourist establishments.

**CAMP SITES.** Hundreds of thousands of people are using and enjoying the fine new picnic and camp sites built and operated by the Liberal Government.


**HIGHWAY SIGNS.** Many thousands of new highway signs have been erected along our main highways. Thousands more will be erected.

**AIRPORTS.** The Liberal Government have built several very important and useful airports and landing-strips for local aircraft. Several others are to be built.

LOCAL AIR LINE. The Liberal Government have given great help and encouragement to Eastern Provincial Airways. The latest help is to provide over two Million Dollars to them to help them buy two big new English Herald-Dart turbo-prop planes to give Newfoundland better air service, especially in Labrador.

WILD GAME. Caribou have been settled in Labrador. Grouse have been settled in Newfoundland. More care has been taken to help our wildlife resources than ever before.

### 6. C.N.T. PAYMENTS

Total amount paid out in wages to the employees of the system, and to extend, improve and modernize the telephone and telegraph system for the people of Newfoundland since Confederation: \$15,000,000. FIFTEEN MILLION DOLLARS!

### 10. TRANS CANADA

Total amount spent by Canada to help Newfoundland build the Trans-Canada Highway since Confederation: \$30,000,000. Still to come from Ottawa for this road: at least \$25,000,000. 
