Phil was born at New Perlican, Trinity Bay in 1933 where he also received his elementary and high school education. Phil then attended Memorial University where he obtained the degrees of B.A.(Ed.) and B.Sc. in 1956 before going to the University of Alberta where he received his M.Ed. (1959) and his Ph.D. (1962)

Immediately following his university training in 1962, Phil became a Professor at Memorial University and served for some of those year (1967-1973) as Head of the Department of Educational Administration. He is presently on leave from Memorial University so that he can devote all of his time to

Phil has always been active in his community. Among other things, he has been school principal, school board member, and member of the Newfoundland Public Libraries Board, the Provincial Health Council, the St. John's Hospital Advisory Board, the St. Luke's Homes Board of Management, and the Canadian Officers Training Corps where he is commissioned as a Second Lieutenant in the Royal Canadian Signal Corps. Phil gained wide prominence as Chairman of the Royal Commission on Education and Youth (1965-68) and subsequently as a member of the General Advisory Committee to the Minister of Education from 1968 to 1974.

Many reports and articles have been written by Phil, including Community Use of Schools, Quality and Equality in Secondary Education in Newfoundland and Labrador. Financing Education in Newfoundland and Labrador, and Public Attitudes Towards Education in Newfoundland and Labrador. These articles have led, in part, to Phil's appointment as Chairman of the Liberal Party Policy Committee.

Phil has lived in Mount Scio District for 15 years with his wife Marie (Brown, Tack's Beach) and their three children.





New Transportation Policies

It is unacceptable to a Liberal government that in an energy rich province such as Newfoundland, people should have to pay among the highest prices in Canada for their electrical needs. A Liberal gover is pledged to reverse this situation — as a first step in lowering the cost of living, a Liberal government would impose an immediate freeze on domestic electricity rates throughout the province. This means, as well, that the **fuel adjustment charge** for household electricity rates will be **eliminated**. Initially this freeze will be for a period of three years.
