Research Objectives

- The objective of this research was to assess the perspectives of Canadians about government activities in Afghanistan, including Canadians' awareness and knowledge of, and support for the different type of activities undertaken by the various government departments and agencies involved. In addition, the study sought to determine the impact that media reports of CF casualties are having on the public's support for the mission as well as on their propensity to join or recommend the CF as a place of employment.



Methodology

- The fieldwork for the Afghanistan Tracking survey was conducted on the Ipsos-Reid Express (CIRE), our weekly national telephone omnibus. Fieldwork was done over the course of 24 waves commencing September 18th, 2006, and wrapping up on March 22nd, 2007. There was a three-week break in fielding over the Christmas and New Year holidays.
- During the course of the fieldwork, the questionnaire was adjusted once, as was the number of completes achieved per wave. The breakdown is as follows:
 - Waves 1 to 4: approximately n= 250 each wave with Questionnaire version 1, margin of error ± 6.25 percentage points 19 times out of 20.
 - Waves 5 to 7: approximately n= 250 each wave with Final questionnaire (as of October 17th, 2006), margin of error ± 6.25 percentage points 19 times out of 20.
 - Waves 8 to 24: approximately n= 500 each wave with Final questionnaire (as of November 7th, 2006), margin of error ± 4.4 percentage points 19 times out of 20.
- In total 10,250 Canadians 18 years of age or older were asked their opinions about Canada's role in Afghanistan, of which 8,500 responded to the final questionnaire.

Methodology

- Weekly CIRE sample was stratified by census division and households were selected from a central telephone-sampling program using modified random-digit dialing. The survey data was weighted to ensure the sample's age / gender composition reflects that of the actual adult Canadian population according to Statistics Canada census data.
- Each week the Department of National Defence received a weekly report updating the results, as well as a wrap up of completes after each 4-week period.
- Please note that in some cases, namely where data is presented on a weekly basis, and where we have broken down data by age and region, the base sizes are small and differences are not statistically significant.
- In the report Chapter 2, when discussing support for Canada's activities in Afghanistan you will see two different symbols associated with events that occurred during a particular wave, or between waves:
 - Canadian casualties in Afghanistan are noted by the following symbol: *
 - Remembrance Day is denoted by the following symbol: **



Summary of Findings

- Findings were very consistent across the waves of the survey:
 - A majority of Canadians say they are unlikely to join the Canadian Forces.
 - Canadians aged 18 to 34 are least likely to say that they are not at all likely to join the Canadian Forces at some point in the future. Almost half of Canadians say they are likely to recommend the Canadian Forces.
 - Canadians indicate that recent events in Afghanistan have affected their attitude toward employment with the Canadian Forces, with a majority saying that they have made them less likely to join the Canadian Forces at some point in the future or recommend the Canadian Forces as an employment option to young people.
 - About one in four Canadians indicate that they are very closely following Canada's activities in Afghanistan.
 - About half of Canadians say they support Canada's activities in Afghanistan, with about one in five offering strong support.
 - Casualties suffered by the CF over the course of the tracking did not diminish support.
 - Roughly three in five Canadians recall Canada's military operations in Afghanistan, and a somewhat smaller proportion (just over half) of Canadians recall Canada's development and reconstruction efforts and diplomatic work.
 - When Canada's military role is described as follows: Canada's military operations in Afghanistan such as helping to secure the environment for the civilian population through activities that include combat, about three in five indicate that they support military operations in Afghanistan.
 - Support is higher for both development and reconstruction efforts and for diplomatic work. Generally, more than four in five support development and reconstruction efforts in Afghanistan and four in five support diplomatic work in Afghanistan. After hearing the brief descriptions provided of Canada's military operations, development and reconstruction efforts, and diplomatic work that are provided as part of the questions on recall and support, Canadians were once again asked whether they support or oppose Canada's activities in Afghanistan. Across each wave of the survey, support increased significantly after hearing more about Canada's role.

Objectifs de la recherche

- Cette recherche avait pour objectif de recueillir le point de vue des Canadiens sur les activités du gouvernement en Afghanistan, notamment la connaissance qu'ils en ont et l'appui qu'ils accordent à divers types d'activités menées par les différents ministères et organismes gouvernementaux concernés. En outre, l'étude cherchait à cerner l'incidence des nouvelles rapportées dans les médias concernant les pertes de vie des membres des FC sur l'appui accordé par la population à la mission et sur la probabilité que les Canadiens joignent les FC ou les recommandent comme choix de carrière.



Méthodologie

- Le sondage de suivi sur l'Afghanistan a été effectué dans le cadre de l'Express Ipsos-Reid (CIRE), le sondage omnibus national que nous menons chaque semaine par téléphone. Le sondage s'est déroulé en 24 phases, entre le 18 septembre 2006 et le 22 mars 2007, avec une pause de trois semaines durant la période des Fêtes.
- Le questionnaire a été ajusté une fois au cours du processus, de même que le nombre de sondages complétés par phase. En voici la répartition :
 - Phases 1 à 4 : environ $n= 250$ lors de chaque phase pour la version 1 du questionnaire, marge d'erreur de $\pm 6,25$ points de pourcentage, 19 fois sur 20.
 - Phases 5 à 7 : environ $n= 250$ lors de chaque phase pour la dernière version du questionnaire (à partir du 17 octobre 2006), marge d'erreur de $\pm 6,25$ points de pourcentage, 19 fois sur 20.
 - Phases 8 à 24 : environ $n= 500$ lors de chaque phase pour la dernière version du questionnaire (à partir du 7 novembre 2006), marge d'erreur de $\pm 4,4$ points de pourcentage, 19 fois sur 20.
- Au total, 10 250 Canadiens de 18 ans ou plus ont donné leur opinion sur le rôle du Canada en Afghanistan, dont 8 500 ont répondu au questionnaire final.

Méthodologie

- L'échantillonnage du CIRE a été stratifié par division de recensement, et les ménages ont été choisis par un programme central d'échantillonnage téléphonique utilisant un système de composition aléatoire modifié. Les données du sondage ont été pondérées pour faire en sorte que, en ce qui concerne l'âge/le sexe, l'échantillonnage soit représentatif de la population adulte réelle, selon les données du recensement de Statistiques Canada.
- Le ministère de la Défense nationale a reçu chaque semaine un rapport des résultats et un résumé des sondages complétés par période de quatre semaines.
- Veuillez noter que dans certains cas, notamment lorsque les données sont présentées sur une base hebdomadaire et qu'elles sont réparties selon l'âge et la région, la taille de l'échantillonnage est restreinte et les différences ne sont pas significatives au plan statistique.
- Dans le chapitre 2 du rapport, lorsqu'il est question de l'appui aux activités du Canada en Afghanistan, veuillez noter la présence de deux symboles en regard d'événements survenus pendant une phase en particulier, ou entre des phases :
 - Les pertes de vie canadiennes en Afghanistan sont indiquées par le symbole suivant : *
 - Le jour du Souvenir est indiqué par le symbole suivant : **



Résumé des résultats

- Les résultats sont très constants dans toutes les phases du sondage :
 - Une majorité de Canadiens disent qu'il est improbable qu'ils rejoignent les rangs des Forces canadiennes.
 - Les Canadiens de 18 à 34 ans ont le moins tendance à dire qu'il n'est pas du tout probable qu'ils rejoignent les rangs des Forces canadiennes à un moment ou à un autre. Par ailleurs, près de la moitié des répondants disent qu'il est probable qu'ils recommandent les Forces canadiennes.
 - Les Canadiens indiquent que les événements récents en Afghanistan ont modifié leur attitude face à l'emploi au sein des Forces canadiennes, et une majorité d'entre eux disent que ces événements ont fait en sorte qu'il est moins probable qu'ils rejoignent les rangs des Forces canadiennes à un moment ou à un autre ou qu'ils recommandent les Forces canadiennes comme choix de carrière à des jeunes.
 - Environ un Canadien sur quatre indique qu'il suit de très près les activités du Canada en Afghanistan.
 - Environ la moitié des Canadiens appuient les activités du Canada en Afghanistan, dont un sur cinq les appuie fortement.
 - Pendant le sondage de suivi, les pertes de vie subies par les Forces canadiennes n'ont pas diminué l'appui envers la mission.
 - À peu près trois Canadiens sur cinq se souviennent d'avoir entendu quelque chose au sujet des opérations militaires du Canada en Afghanistan, et une proportion un peu moindre (un peu plus de la moitié) se souvient d'avoir entendu parler des efforts de développement et de reconstruction et du travail diplomatique du Canada.
 - Lorsque le rôle militaire du Canada est décrit comme suit : Les opérations militaires du Canada en Afghanistan, comme aider à sécuriser l'environnement pour la population civile par des activités qui comprennent des combats, environ trois répondants sur cinq indiquent qu'ils sont pour les opérations militaires en Afghanistan.
 - L'appui est plus élevé en ce qui concerne les efforts de développement et de reconstruction et le travail diplomatique. De manière générale, plus de quatre répondants sur cinq sont pour les efforts de développement et de reconstruction en Afghanistan, et quatre sur cinq sont en faveur du travail diplomatique dans ce pays. Dans le cadre des questions sur le connaissance et sur l'appui, on a lu aux répondants de courtes descriptions des opérations militaires, des efforts de développement et de reconstruction et du travail diplomatique du Canada. Puis on leur a de nouveau demandé s'ils étaient pour ou contre les activités du Canada en Afghanistan. Dans chacune des phases du sondage, l'appui augmente de façon significative une fois que les répondants en savent davantage sur le rôle du Canada.

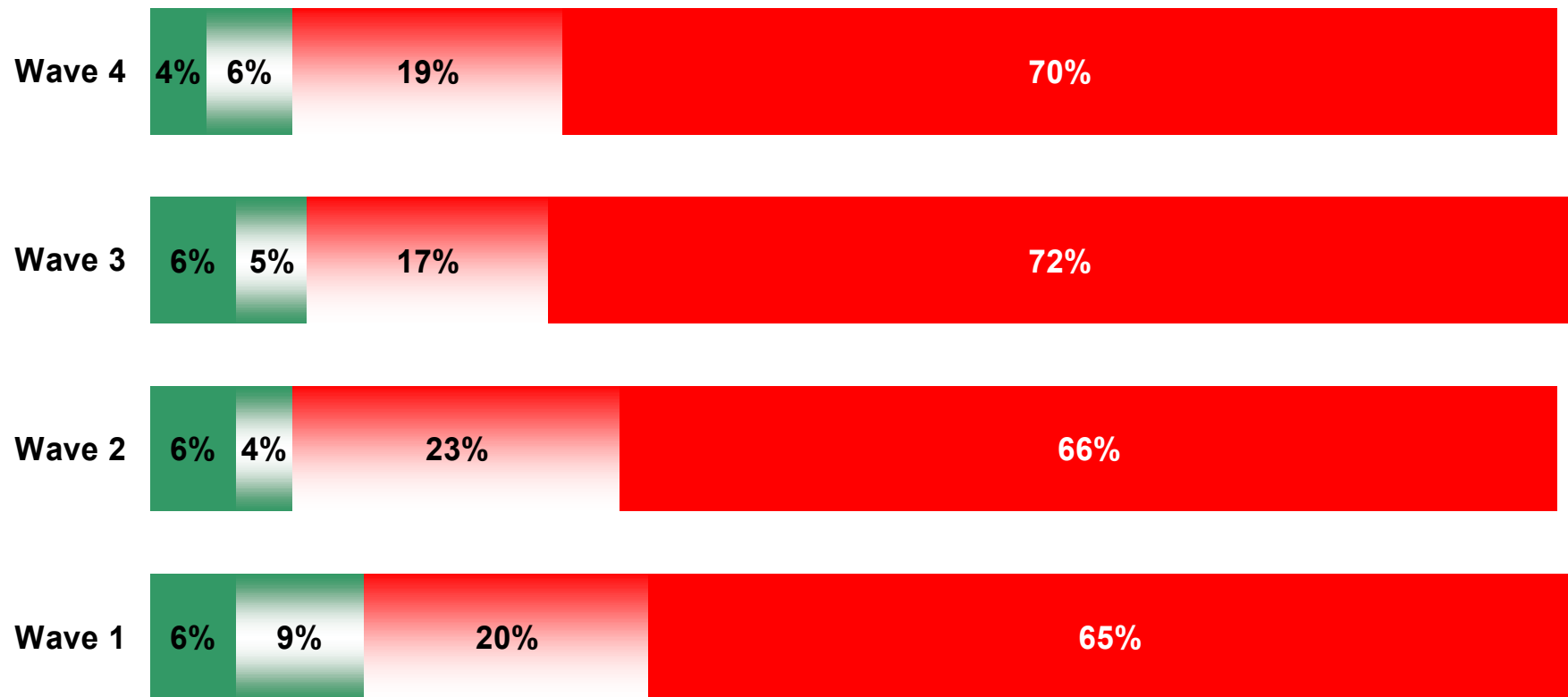


Likelihood of Joining Canadian Forces

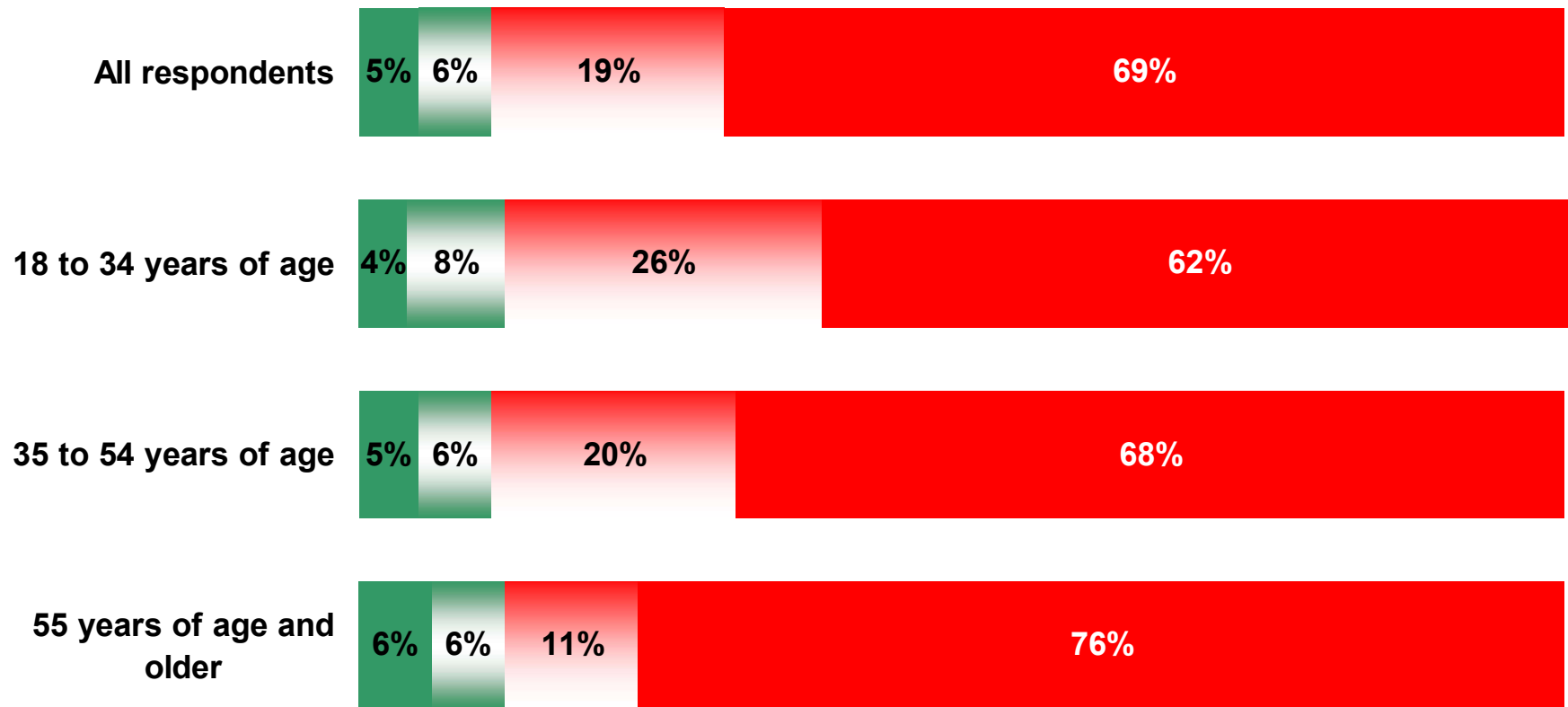


Likelihood of Joining Canadian Forces (Roll-up Waves 1 to 4)

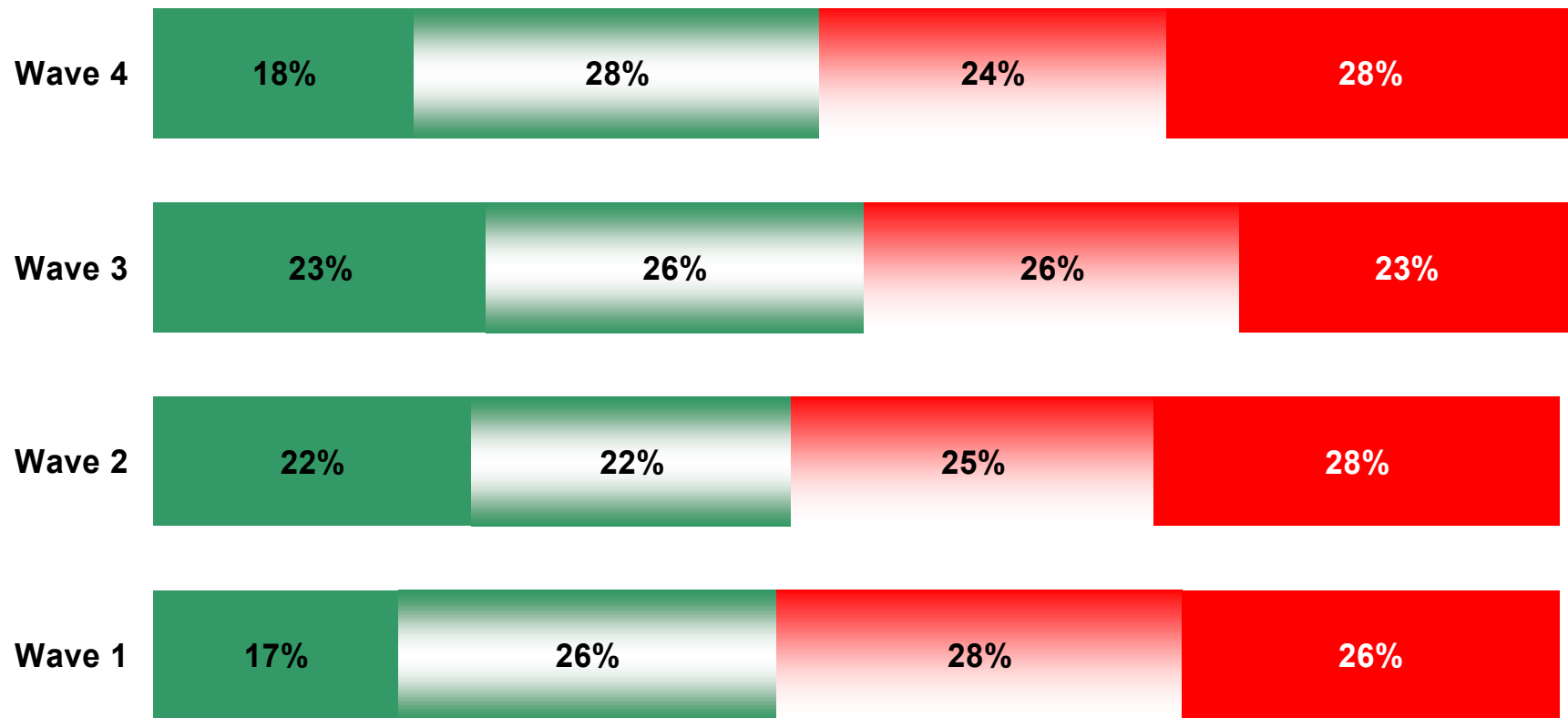




Likelihood of Recommending Canadian Forces

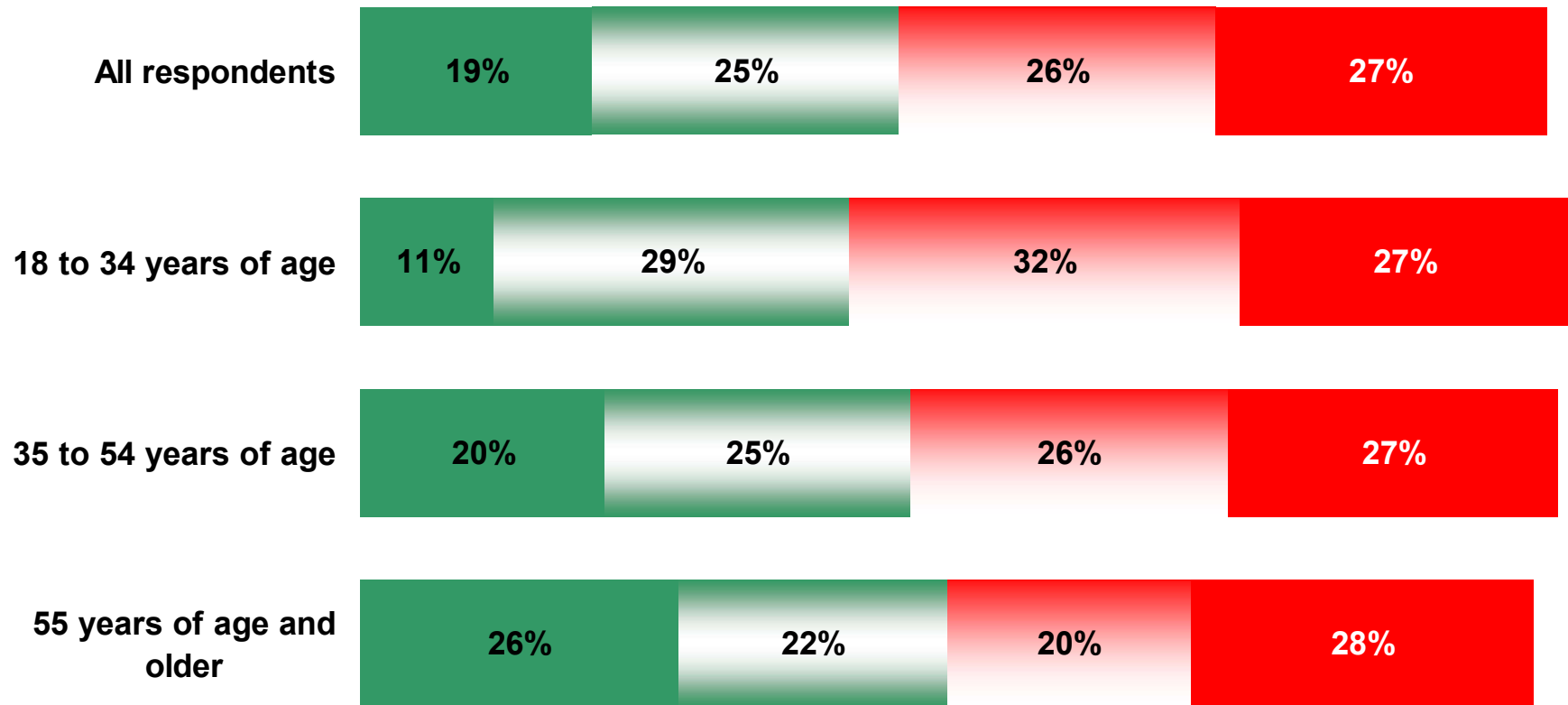




Likelihood of Recommending Canadian Forces (Roll-up Waves 1 to 4)

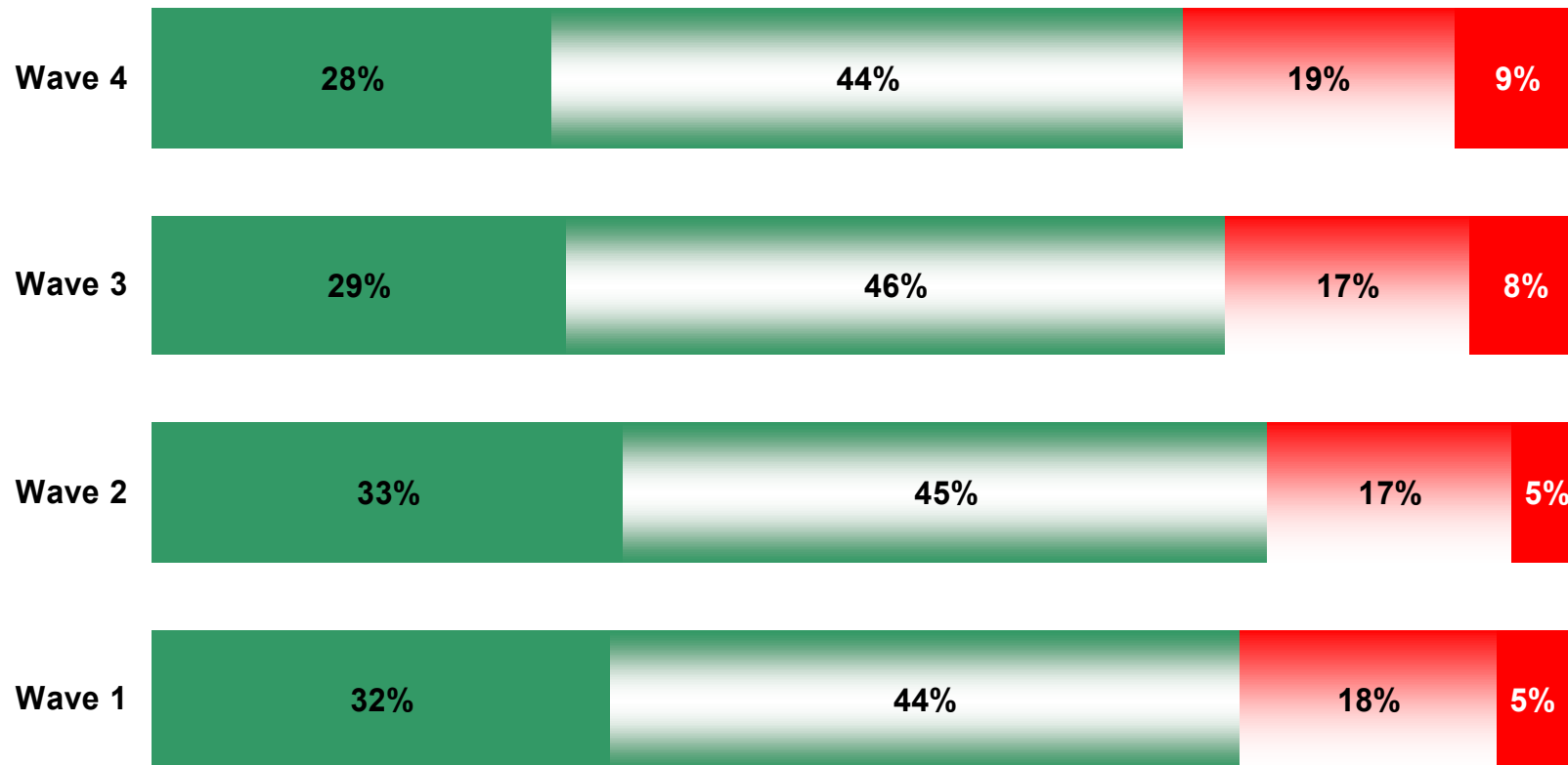




Incidence of Canadians Following Canada's Activities in Afghanistan

How closely would you say you have been following Canada's activities in Afghanistan?

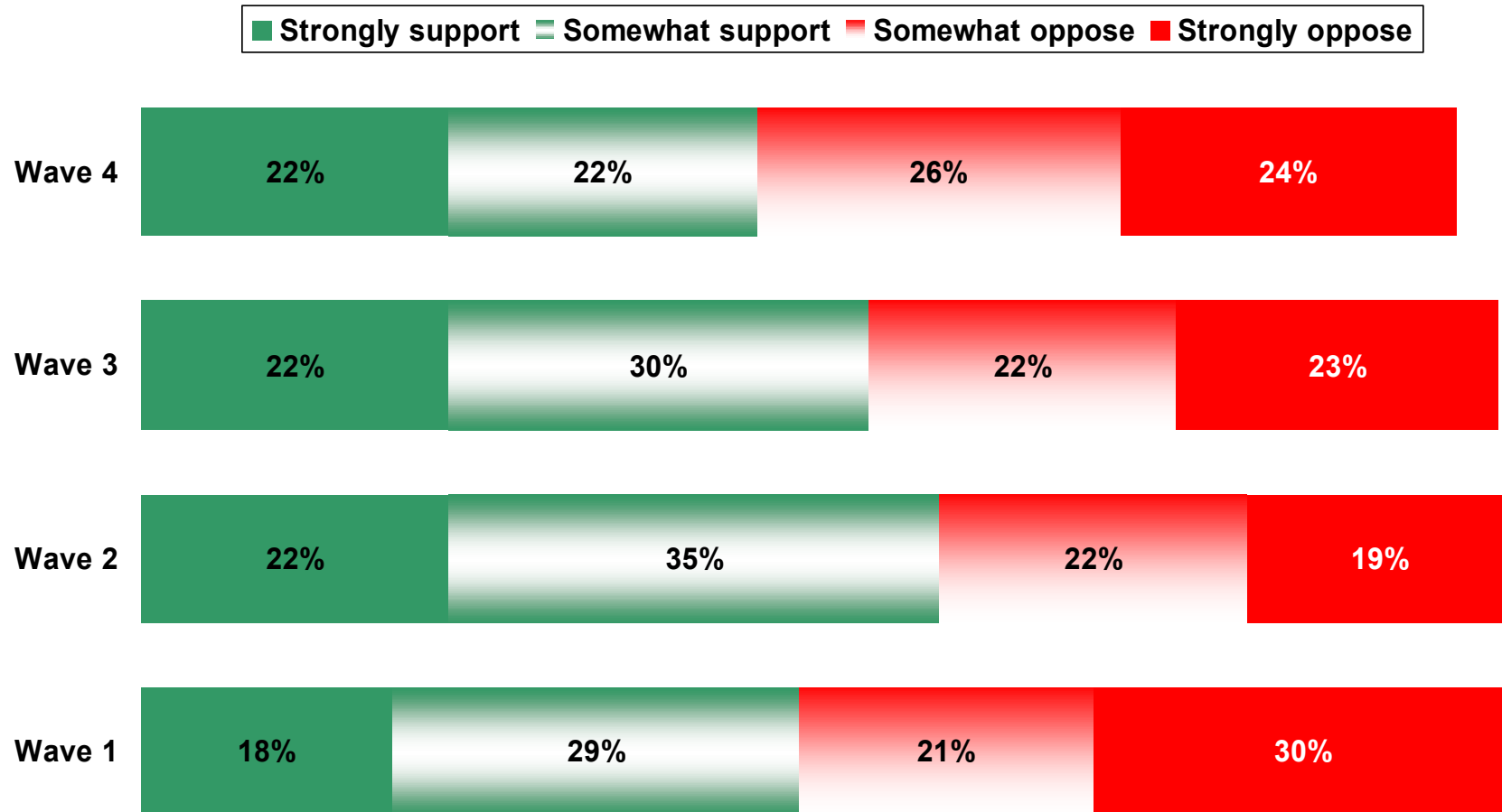

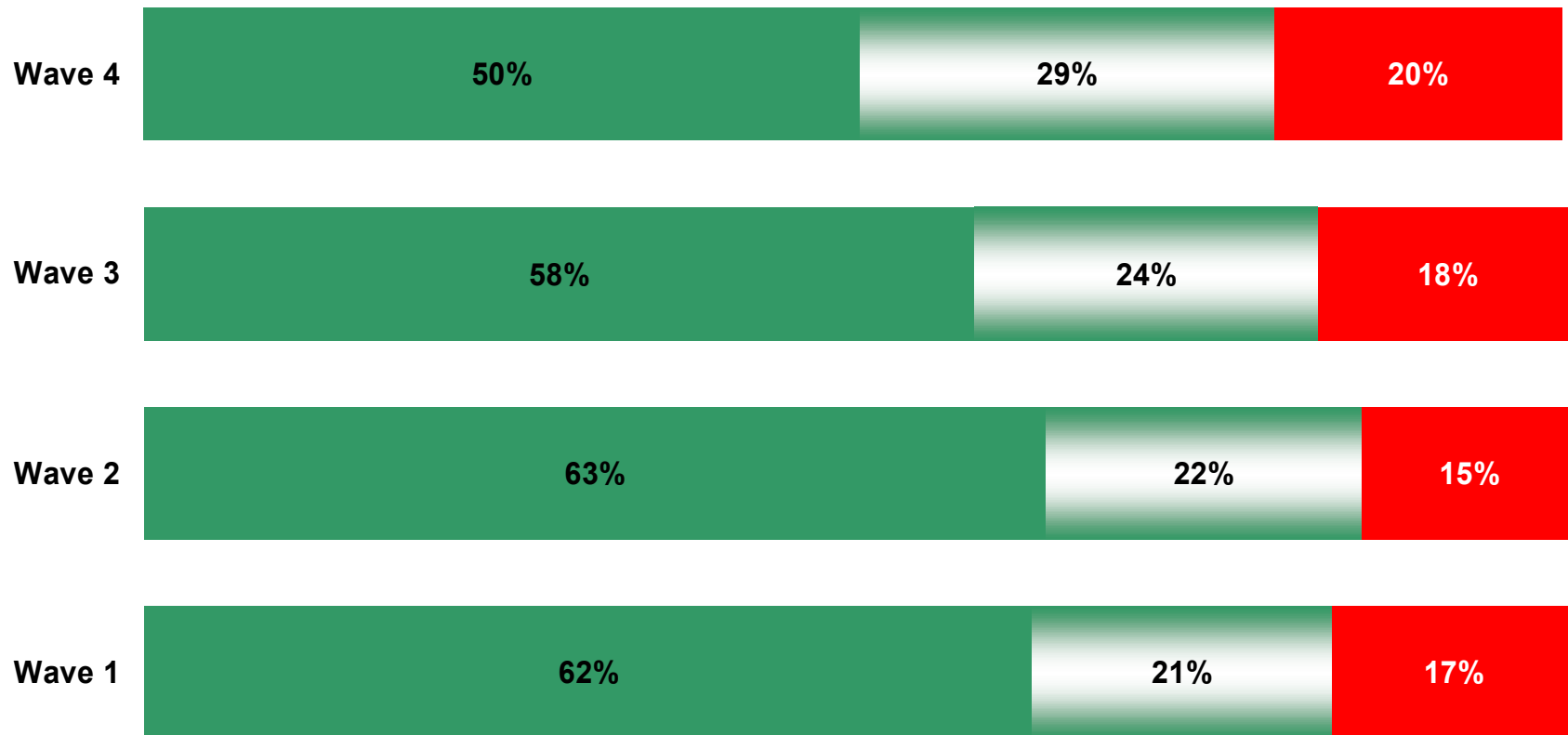




Recall of Military Operations

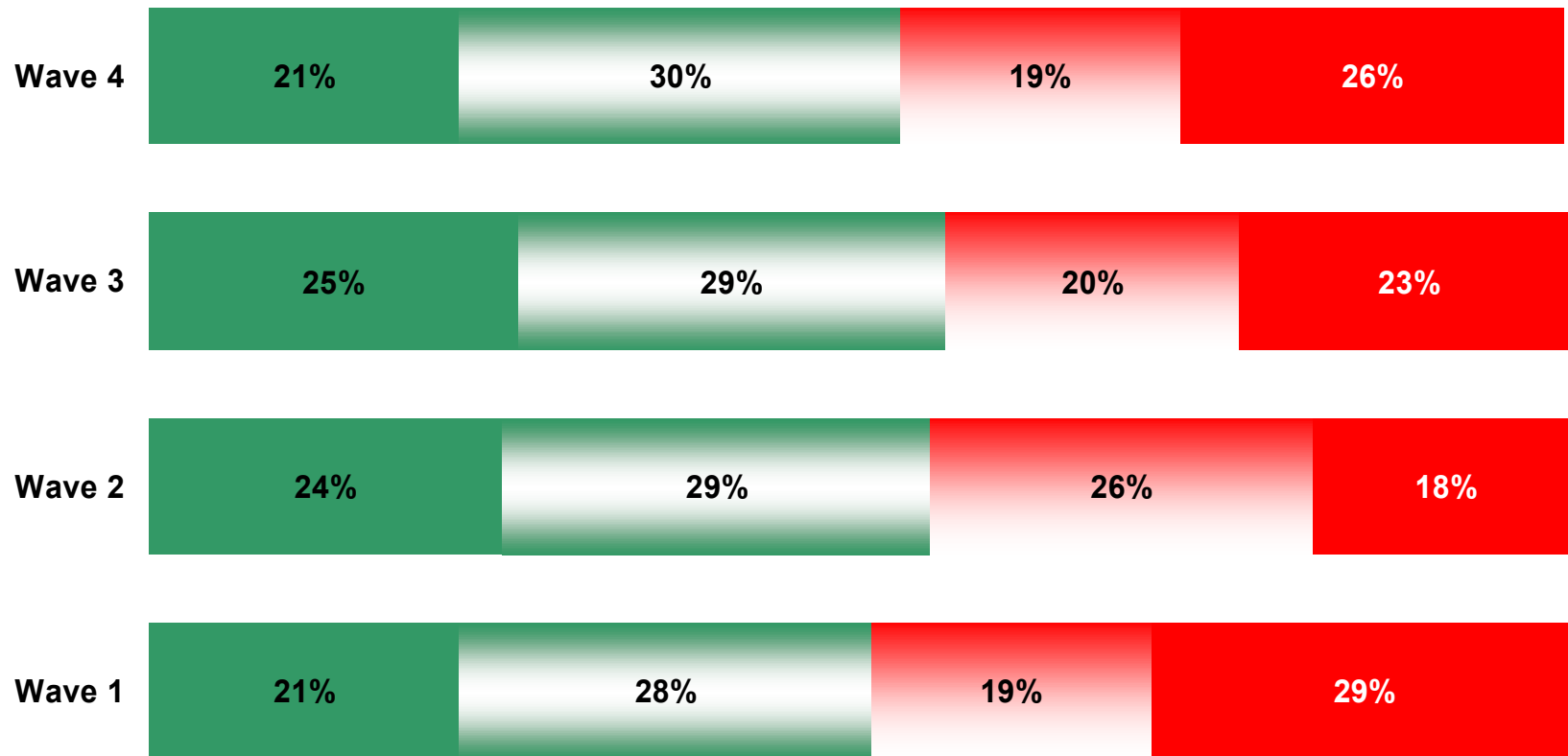




Support for Military Operations

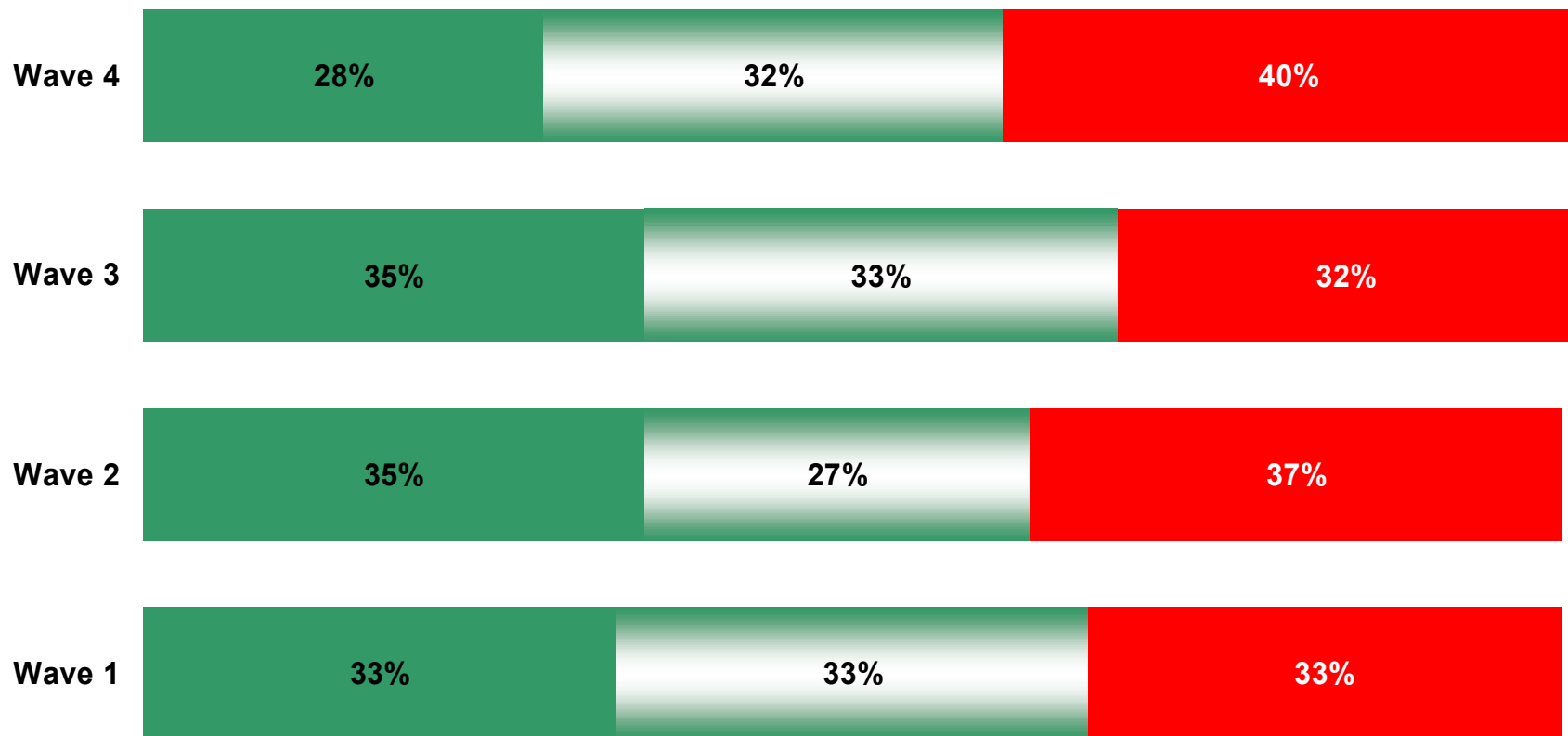

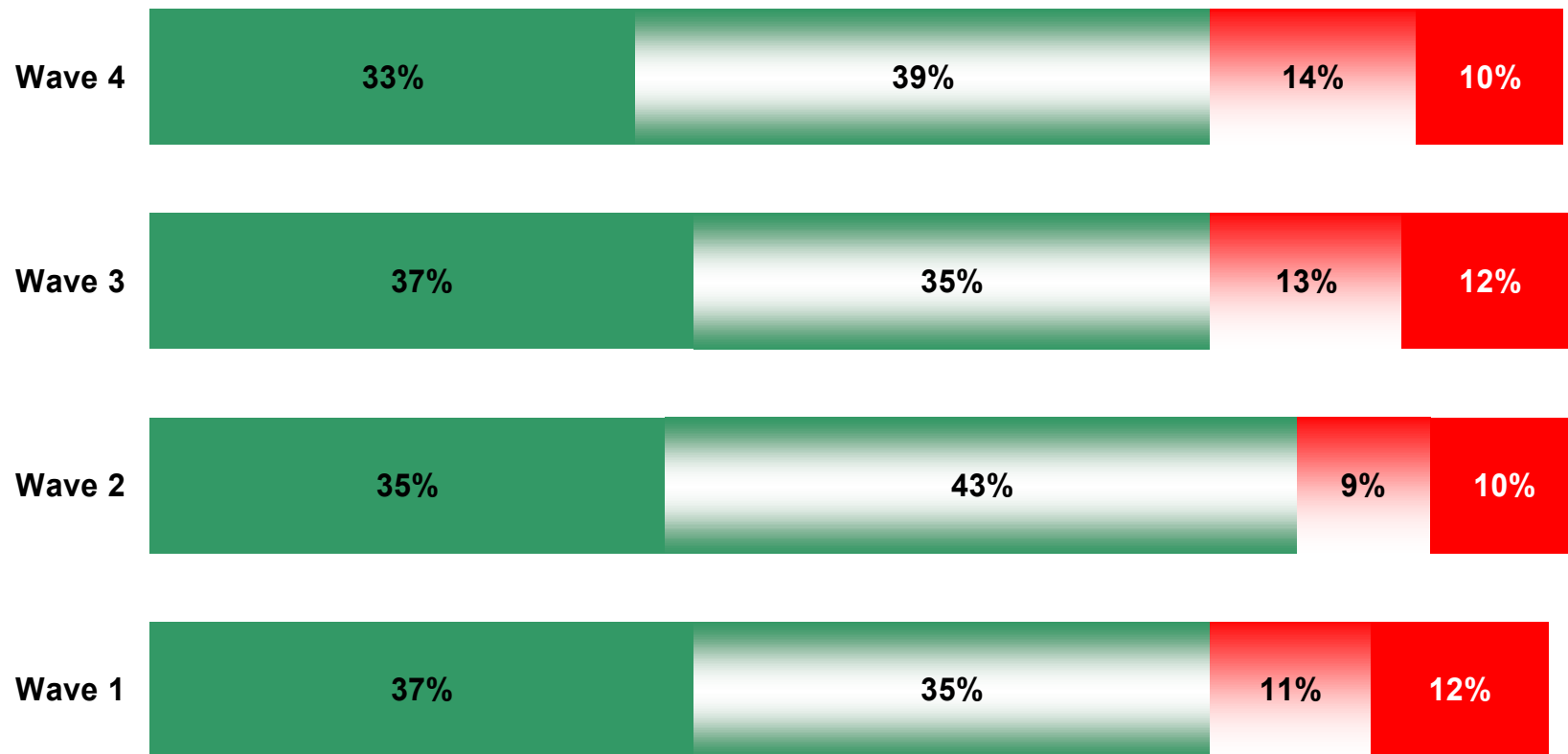




Support for Development and Reconstruction Efforts

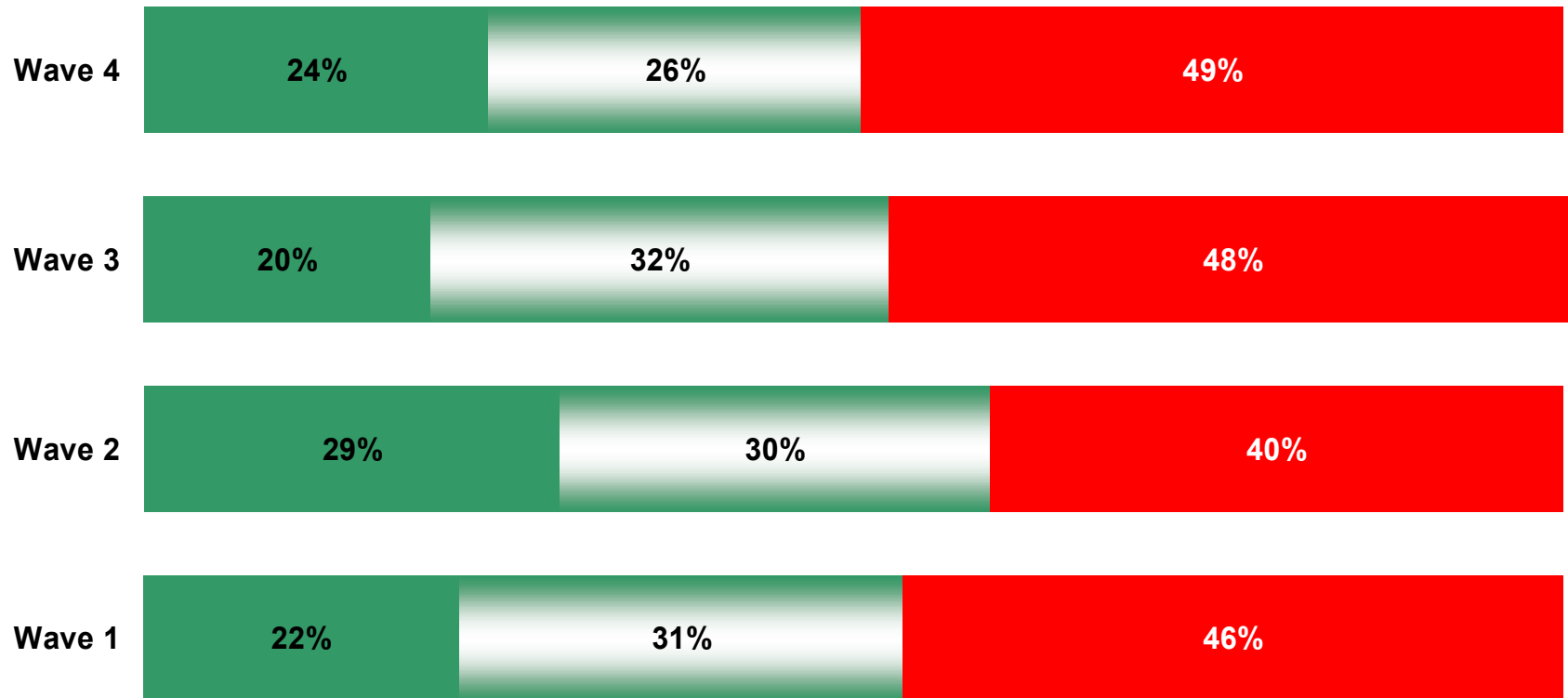

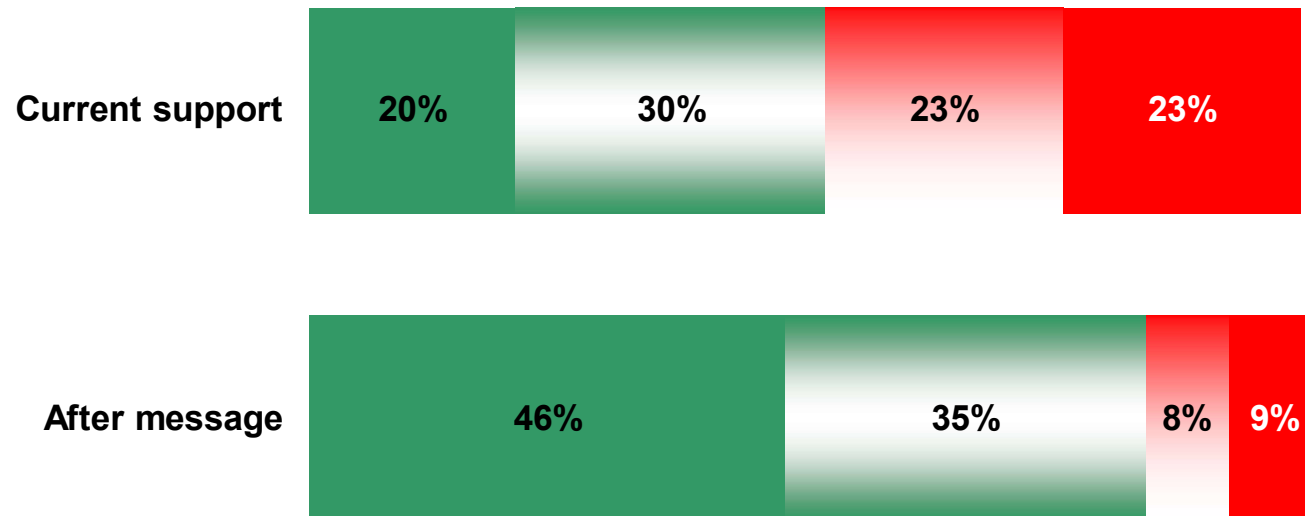

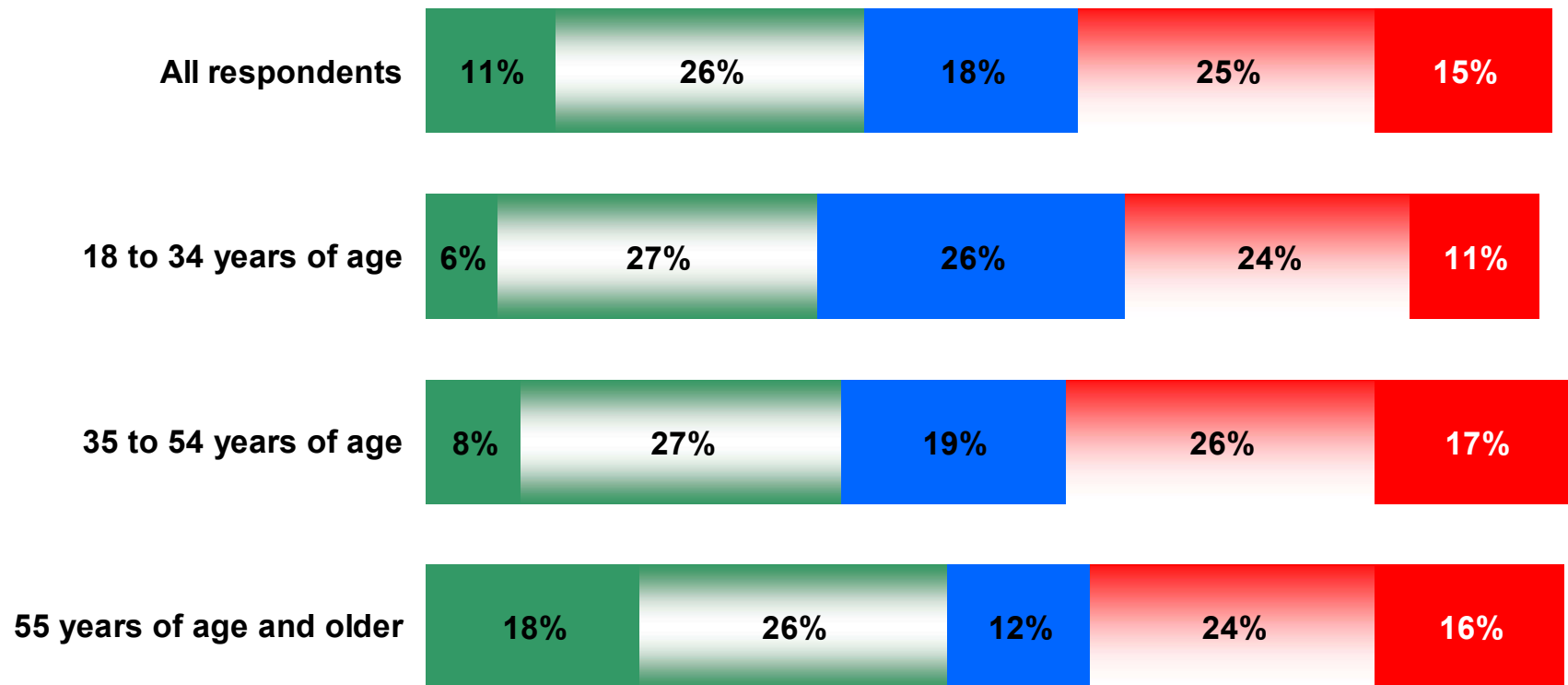
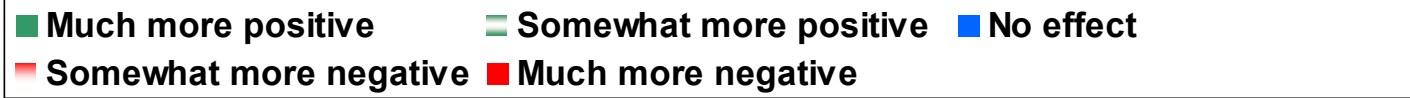

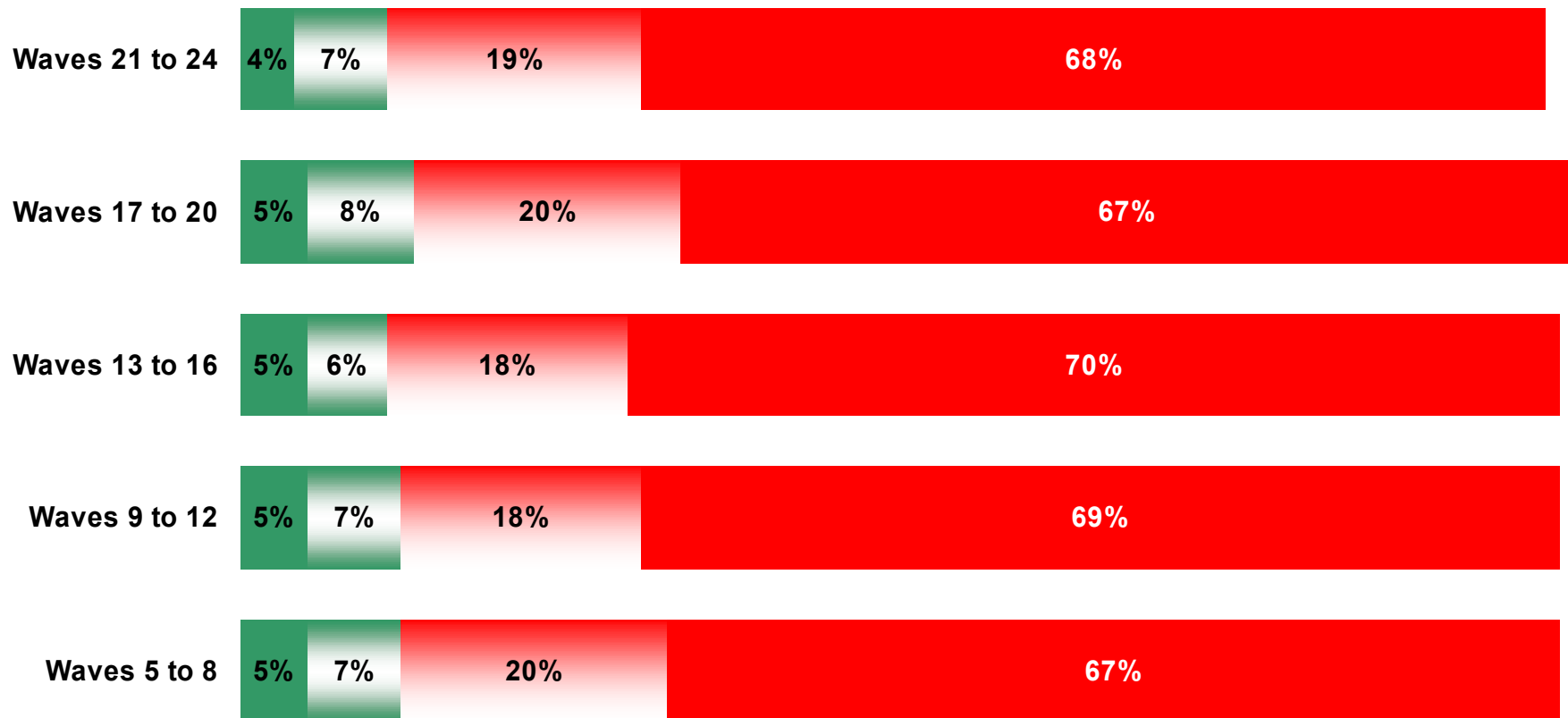


Likelihood of Joining Canadian Forces (Roll-up)

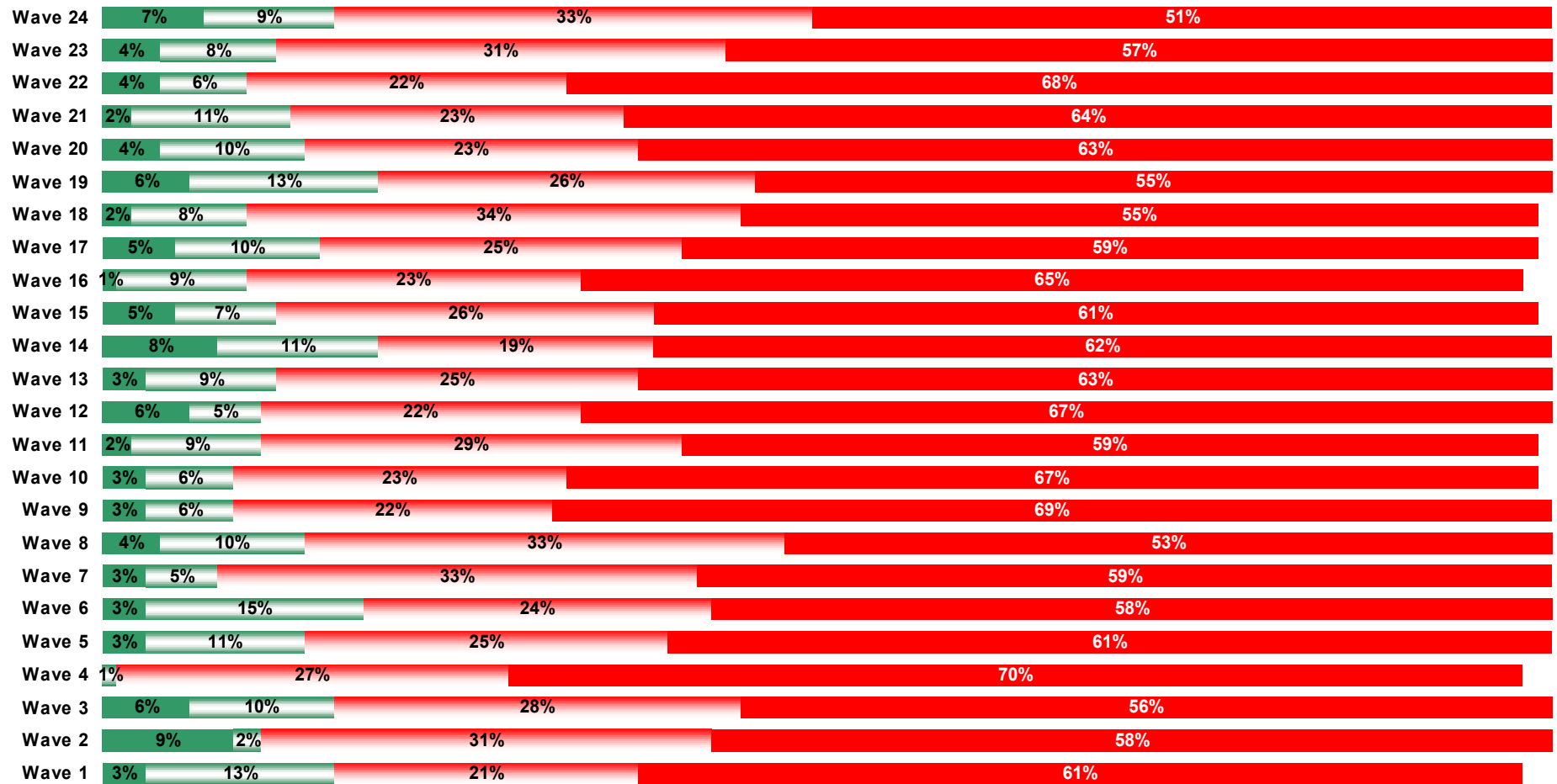


Likelihood of Joining Canadian Forces (18 to 34 year olds)

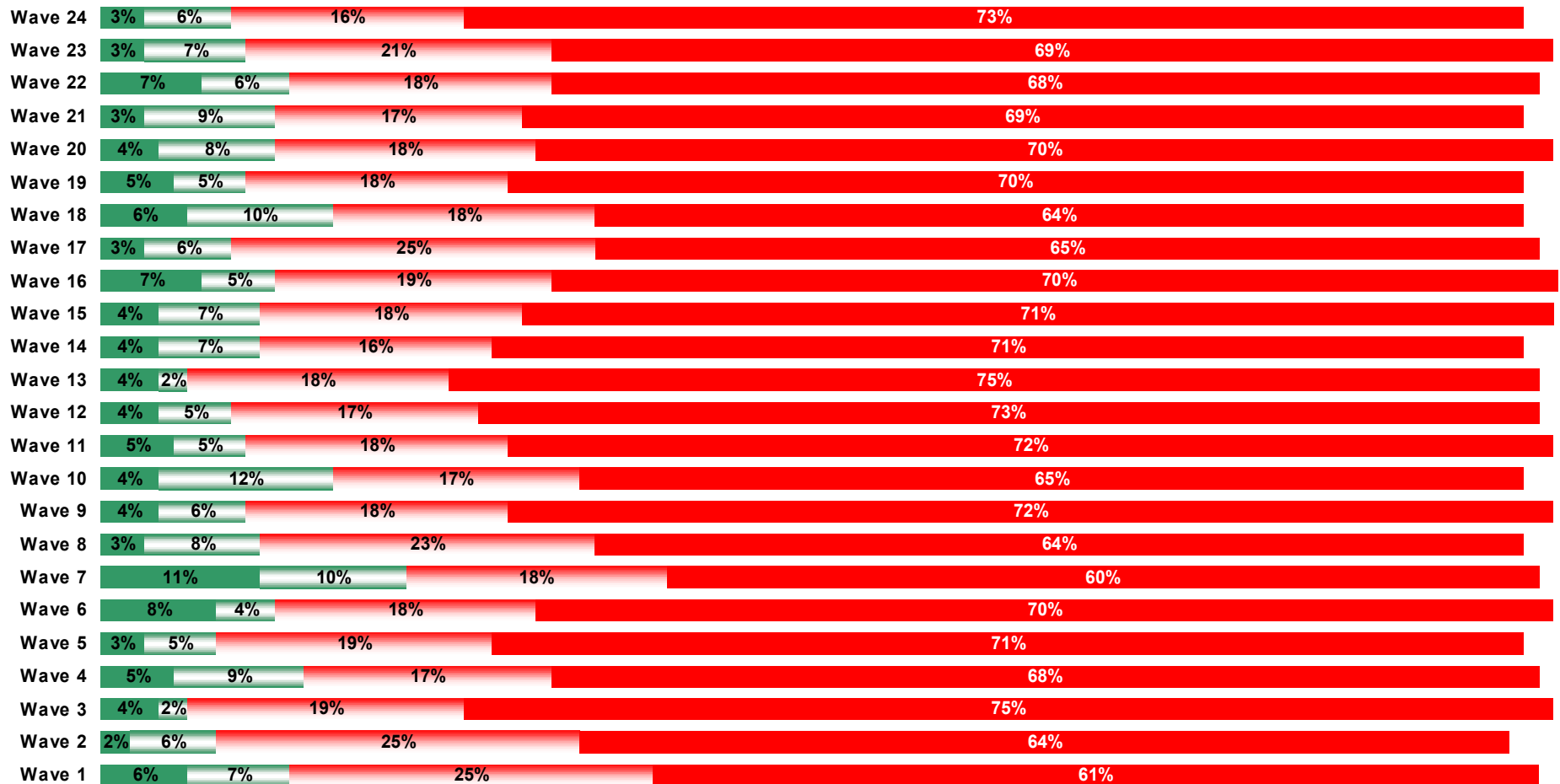


Likelihood of Joining Canadian Forces (35 to 54 year olds)

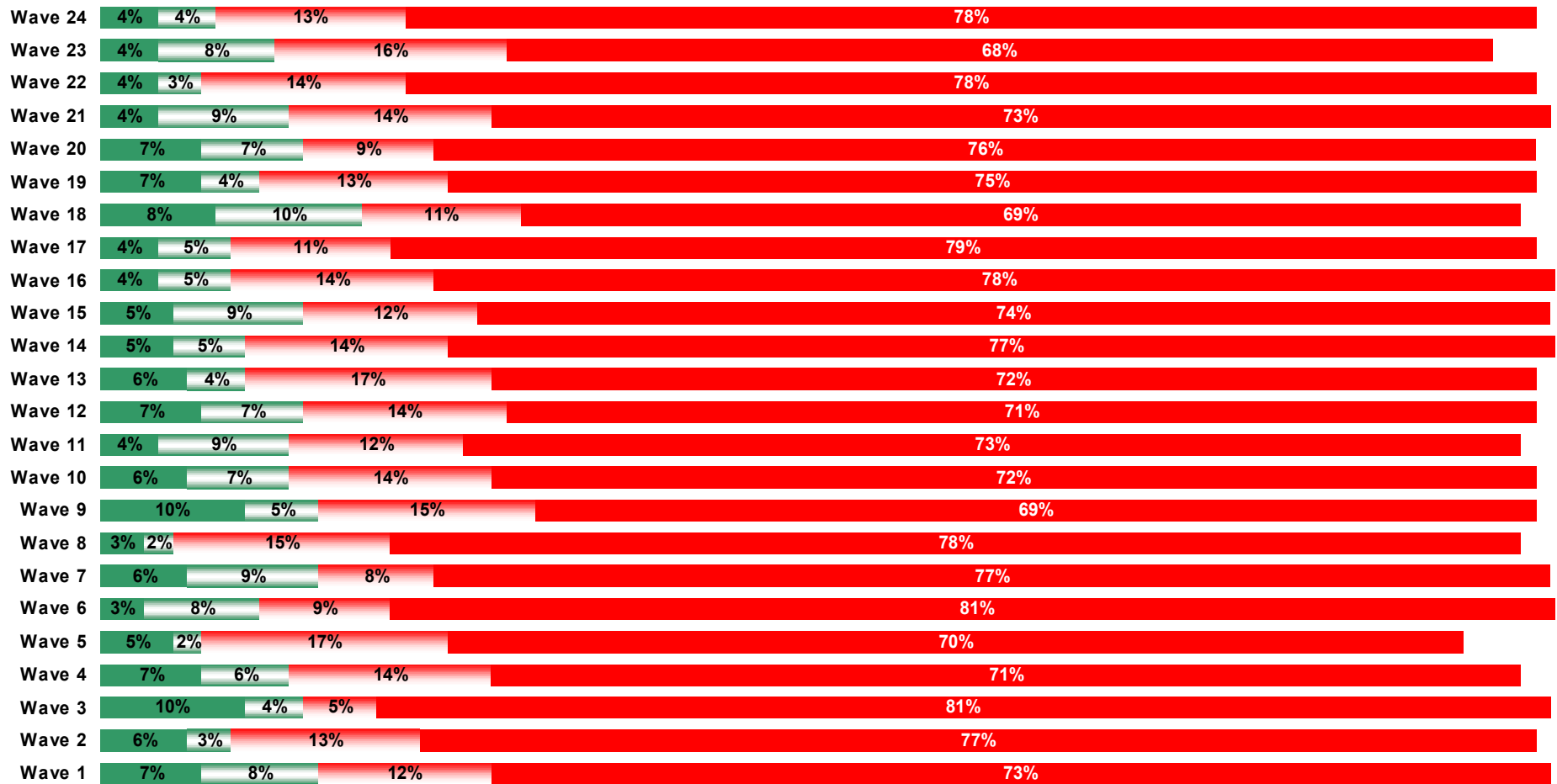


Likelihood of Joining Canadian Forces (55 years or older)

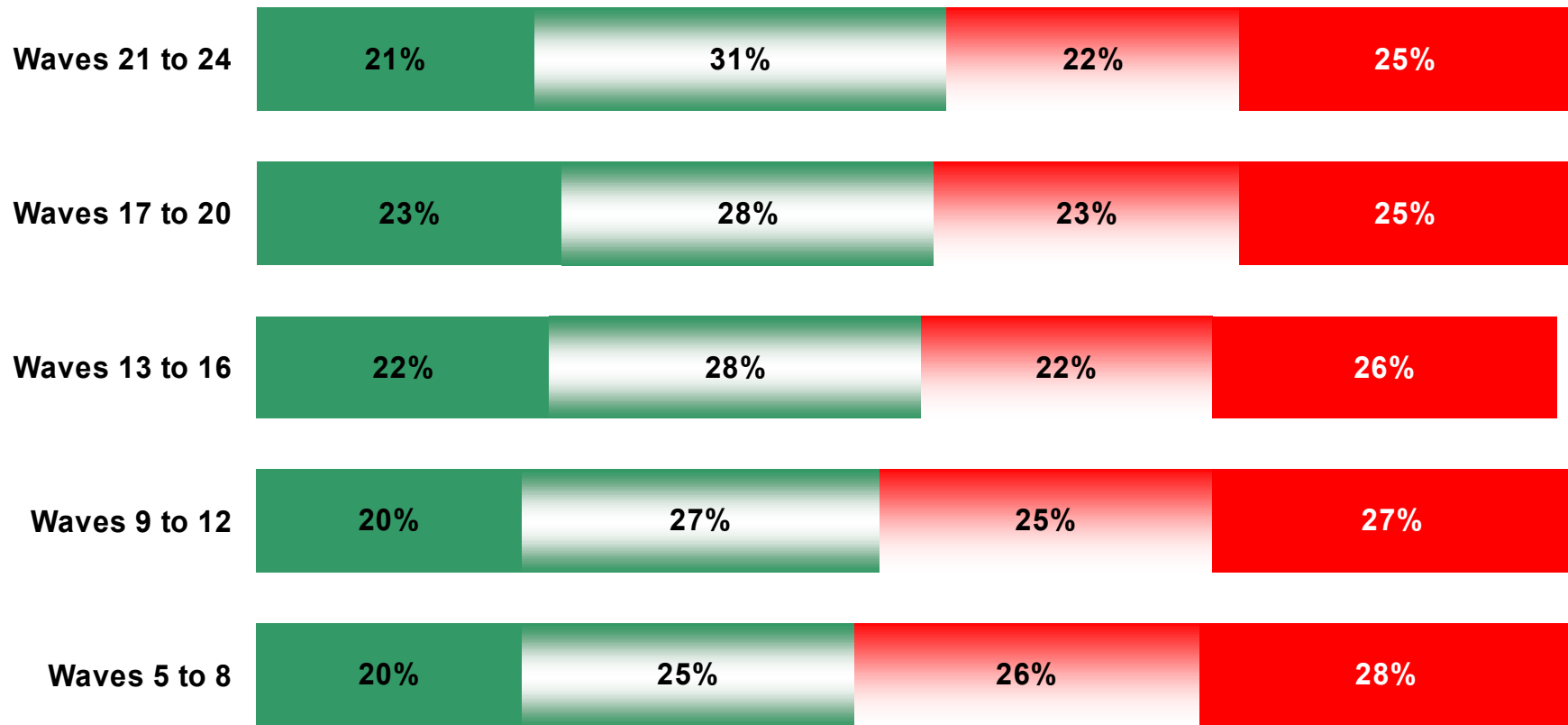

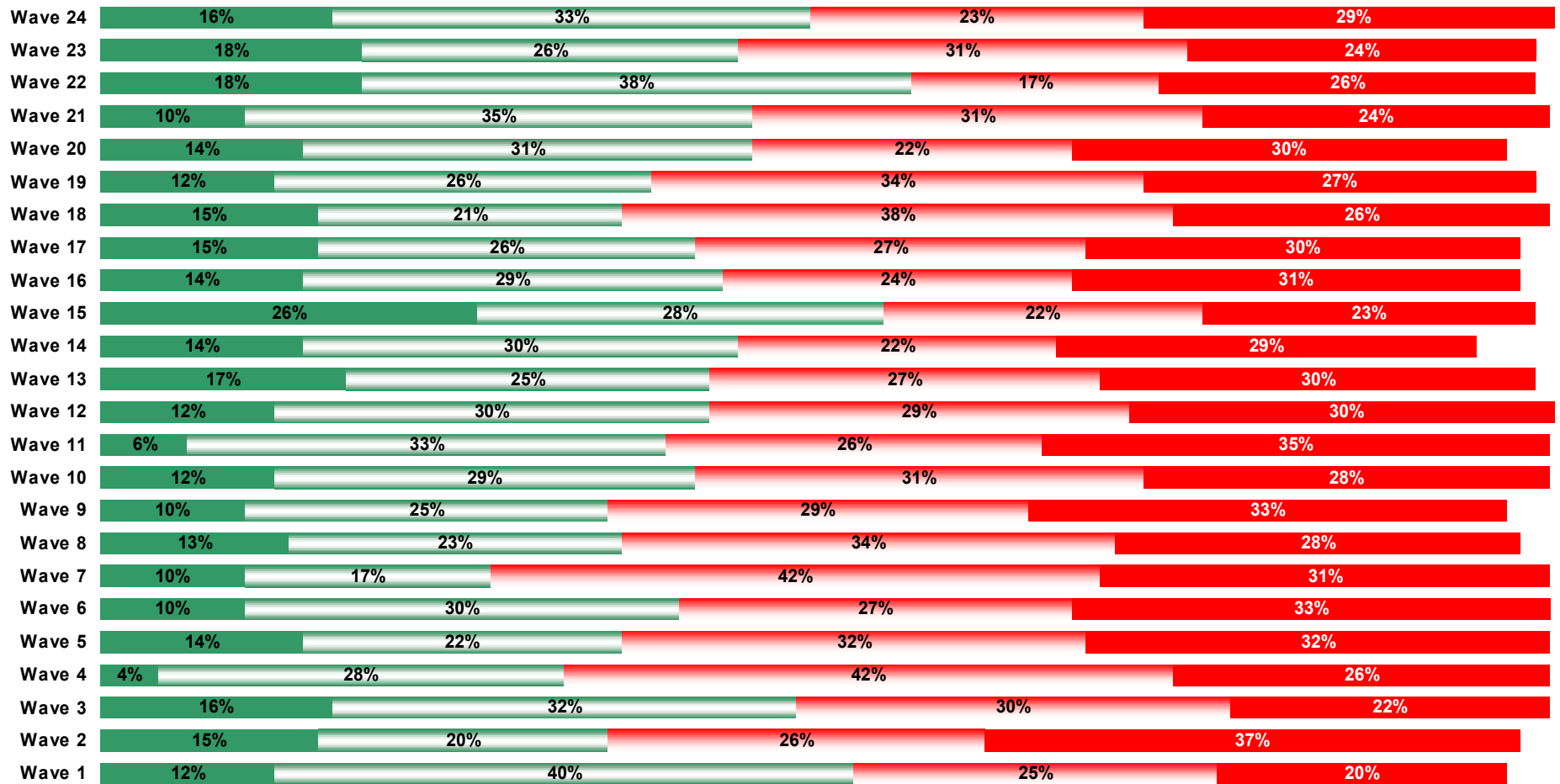




Likelihood of Recommending Canadian Forces (18 to 34 year olds)

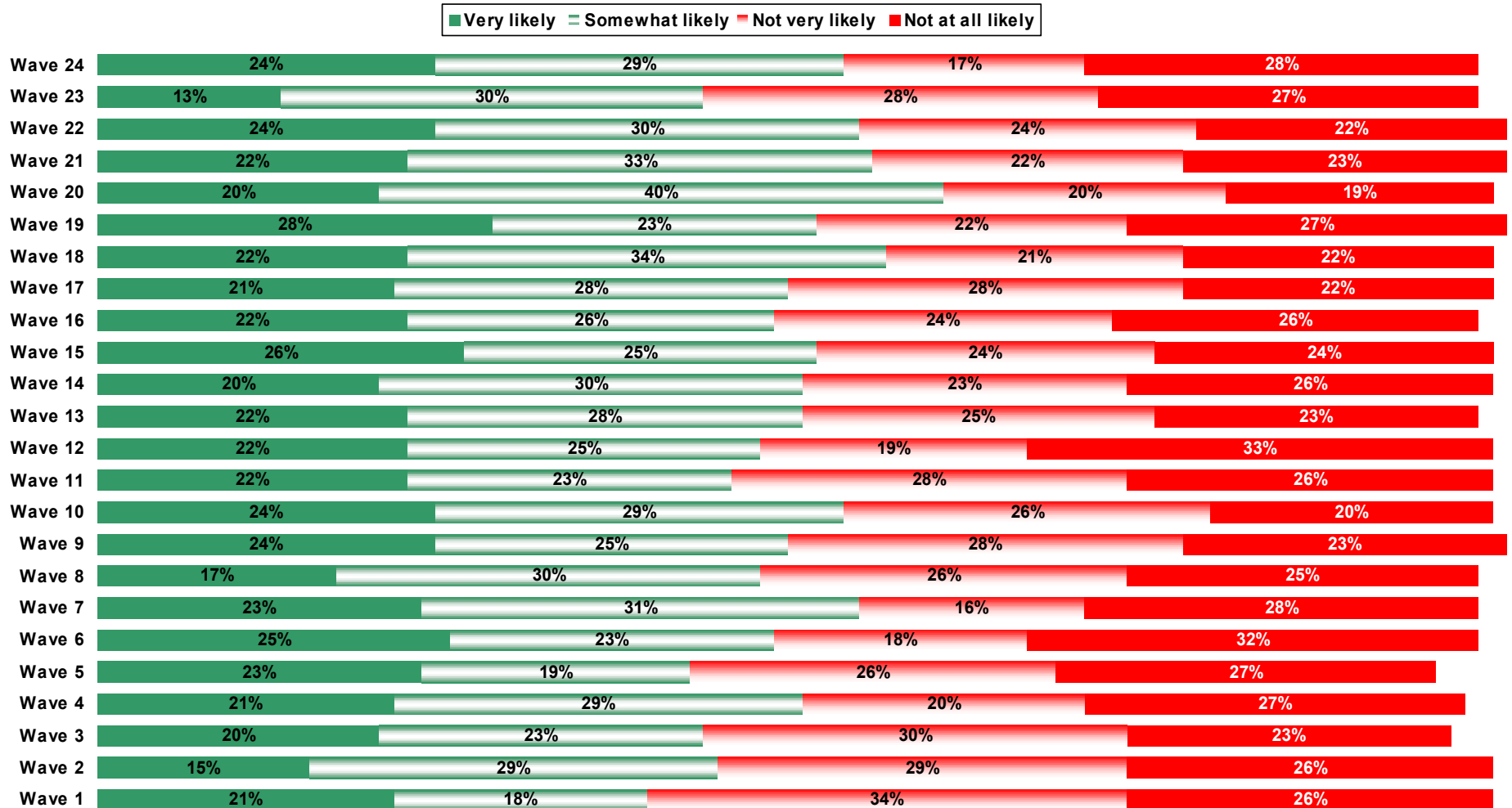

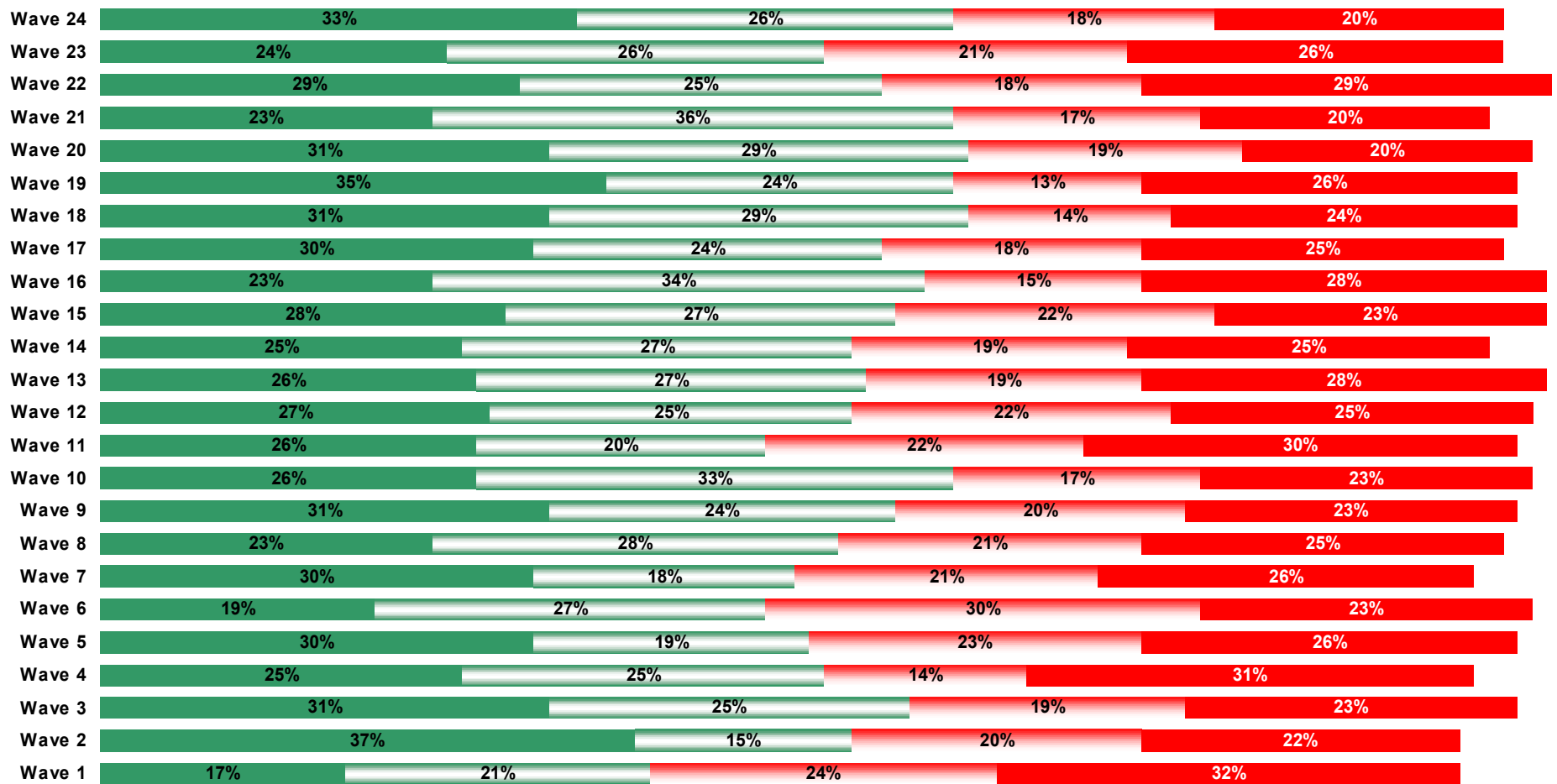

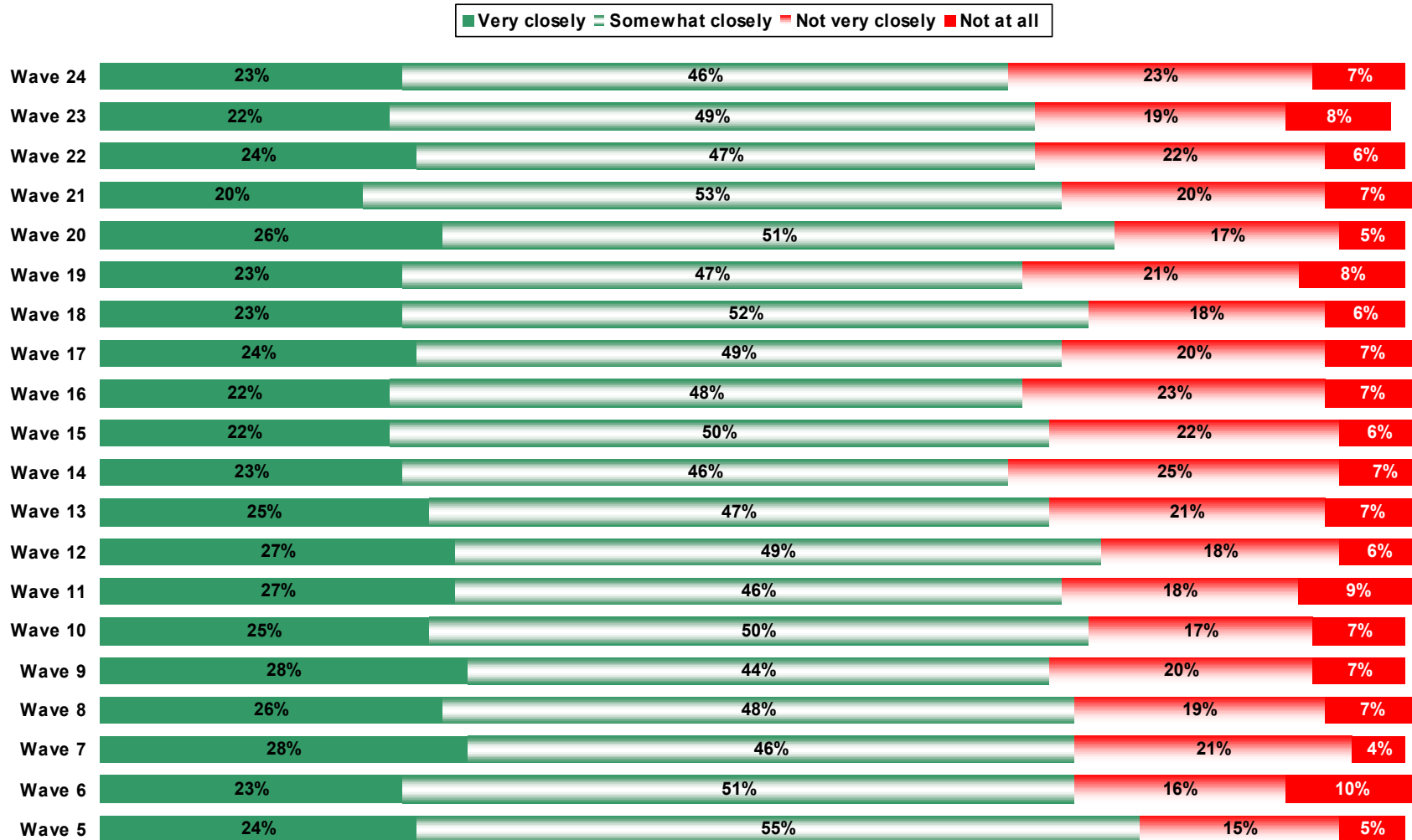

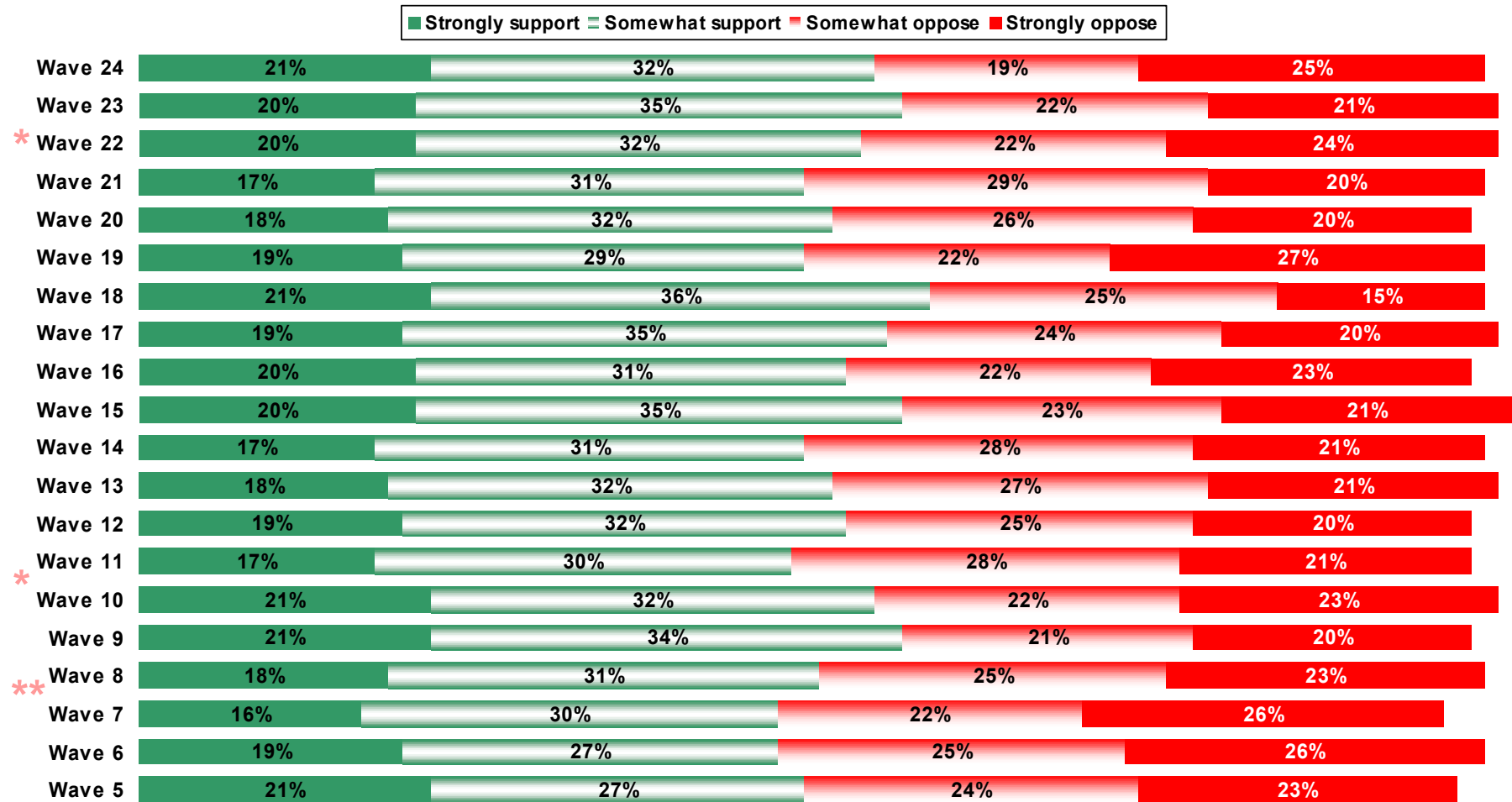

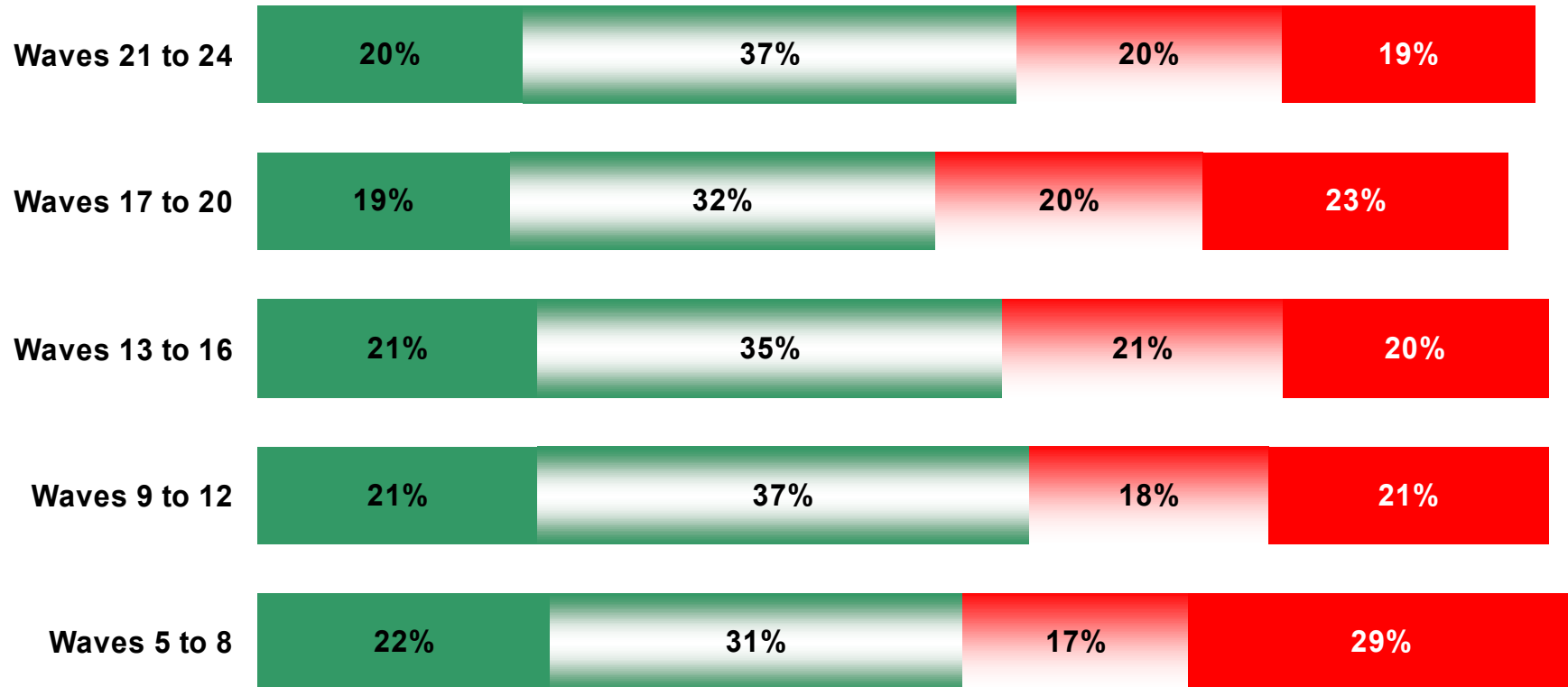


Support for Canada's Activities in Afghanistan (Roll-up): British Columbia

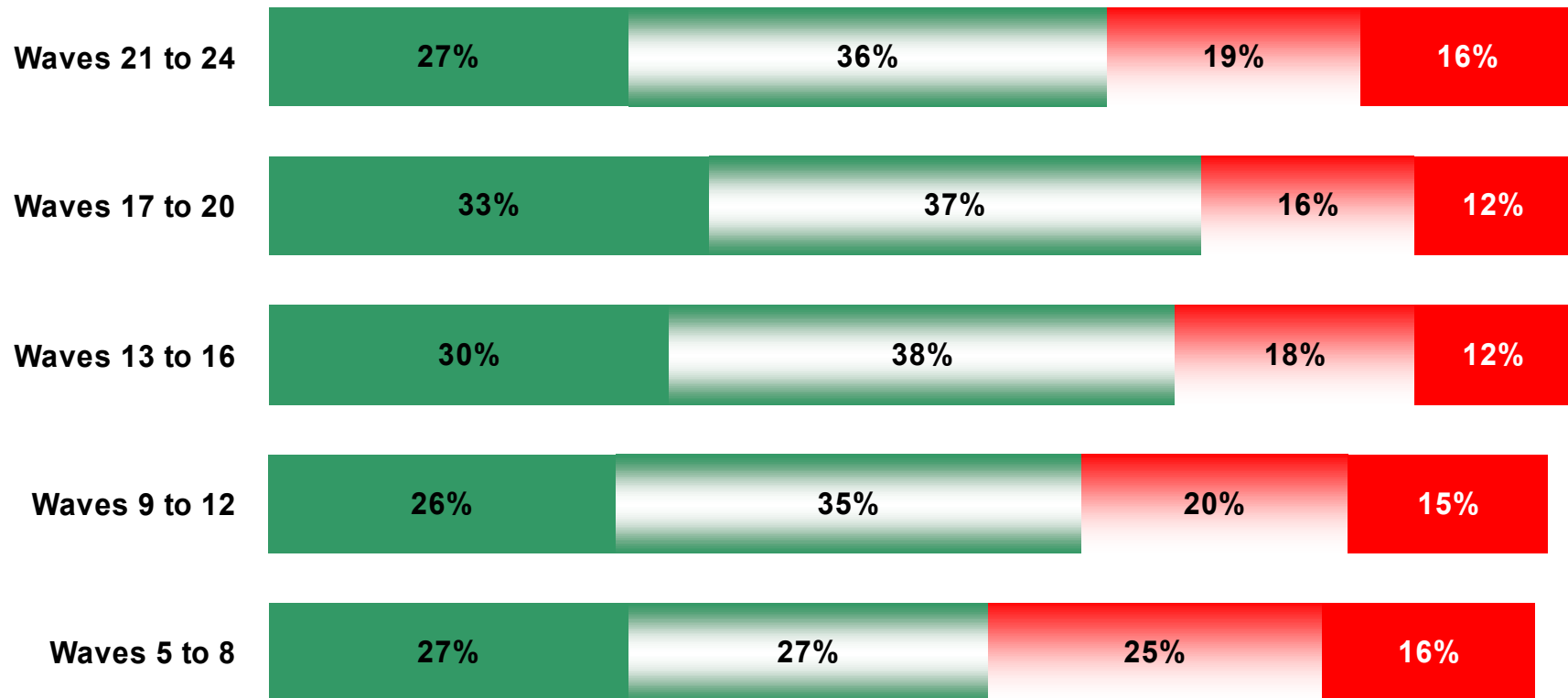


Support for Canada's Activities in Afghanistan (Roll-up): Alberta

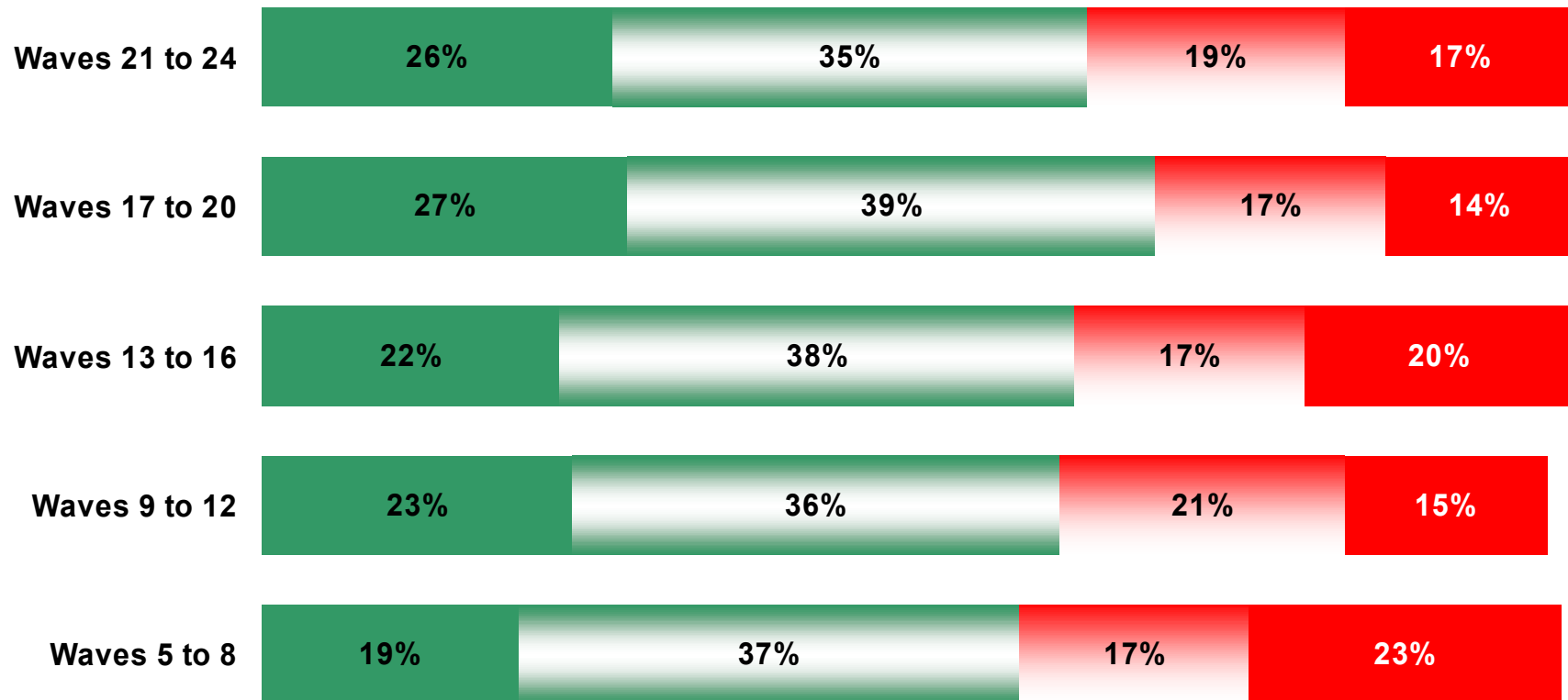


Support for Canada's Activities in Afghanistan (Roll-up): Saskatchewan/Manitoba

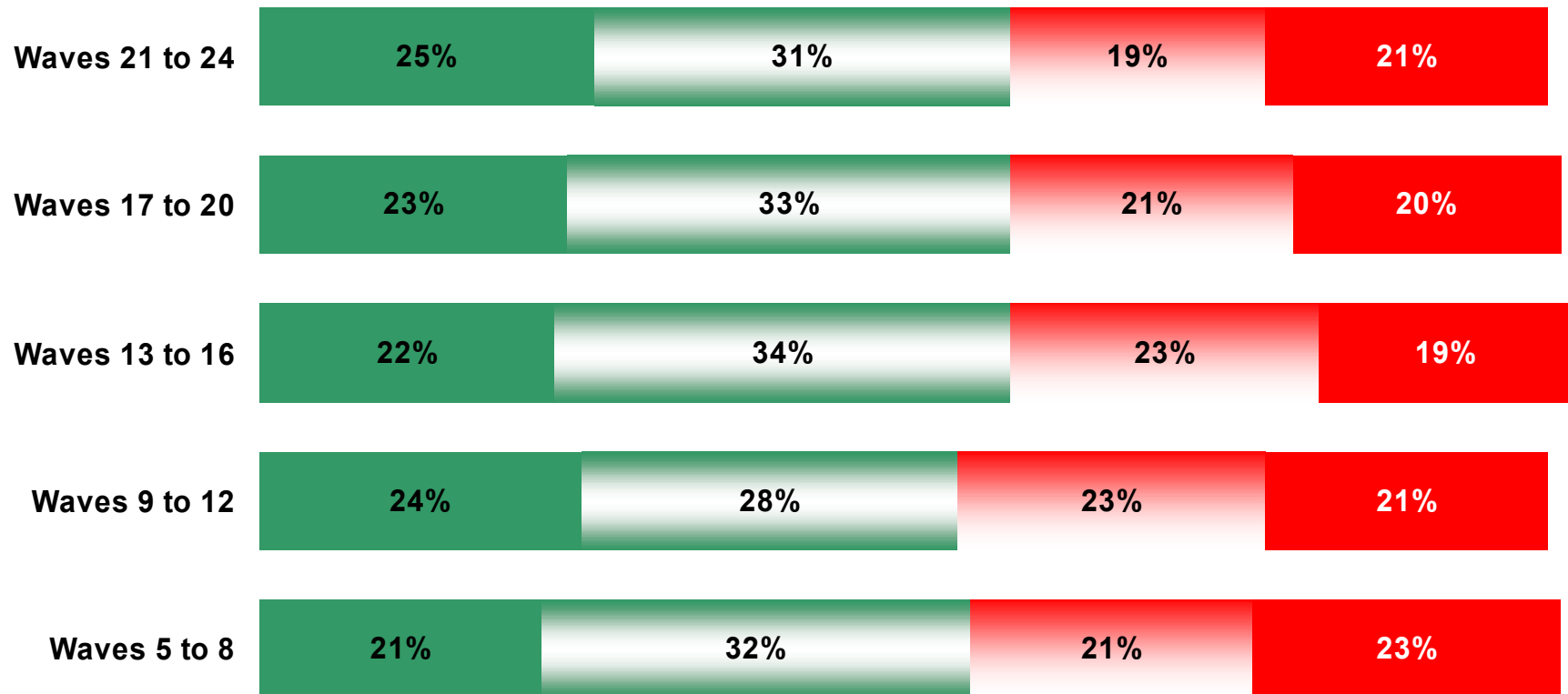


Support for Canada's Activities in Afghanistan (Roll-up): Ontario

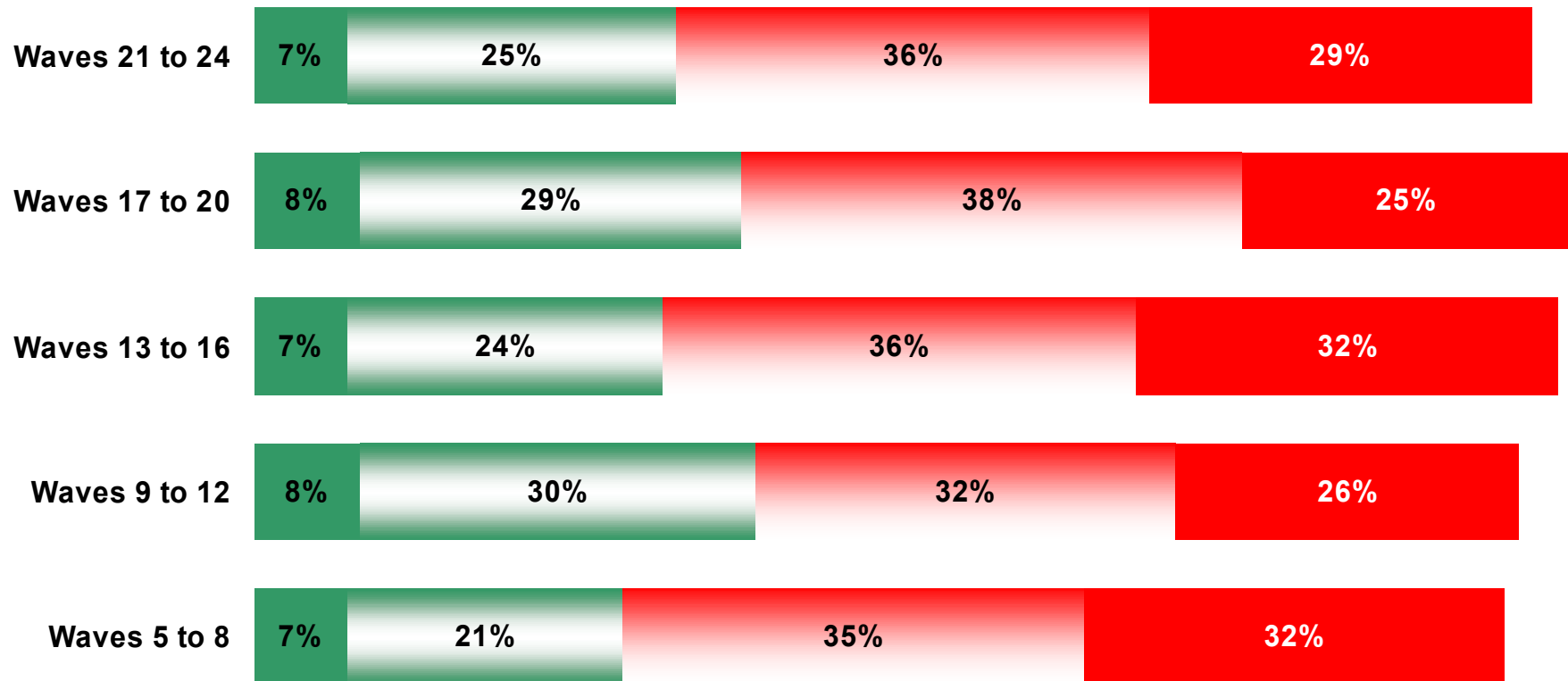


Support for Canada's Activities in Afghanistan (Roll-up): Quebec

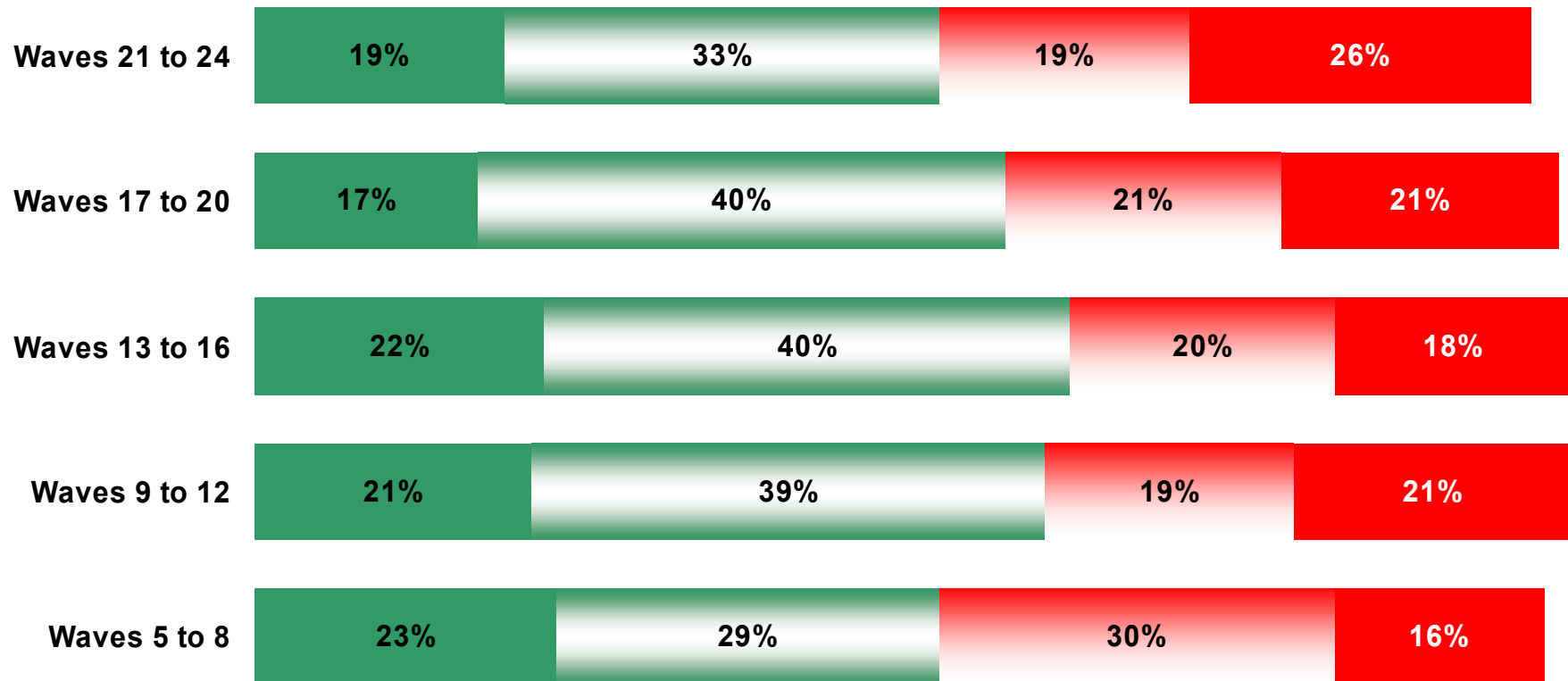


Support for Canada's Activities in Afghanistan (Roll-up): Atlantic

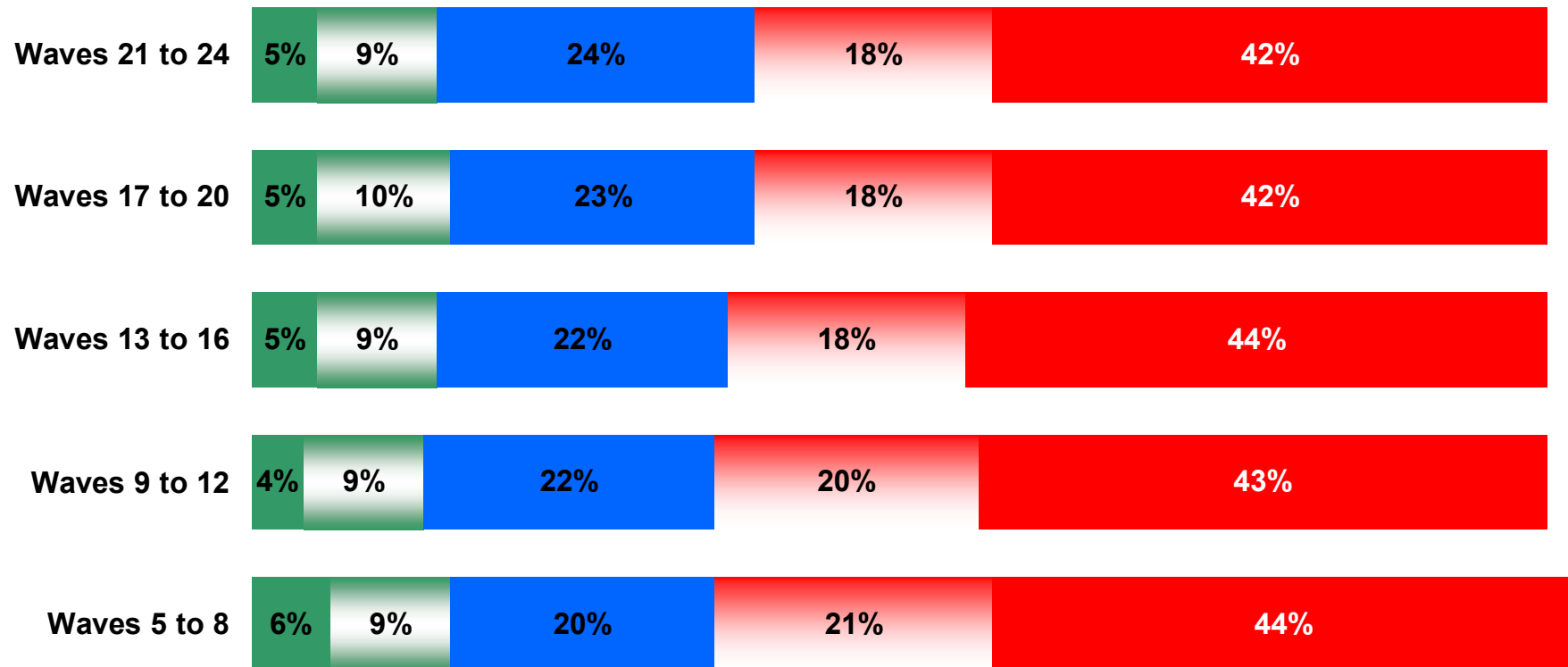
Impact of Events on Likelihood of Joining/Recommending CF

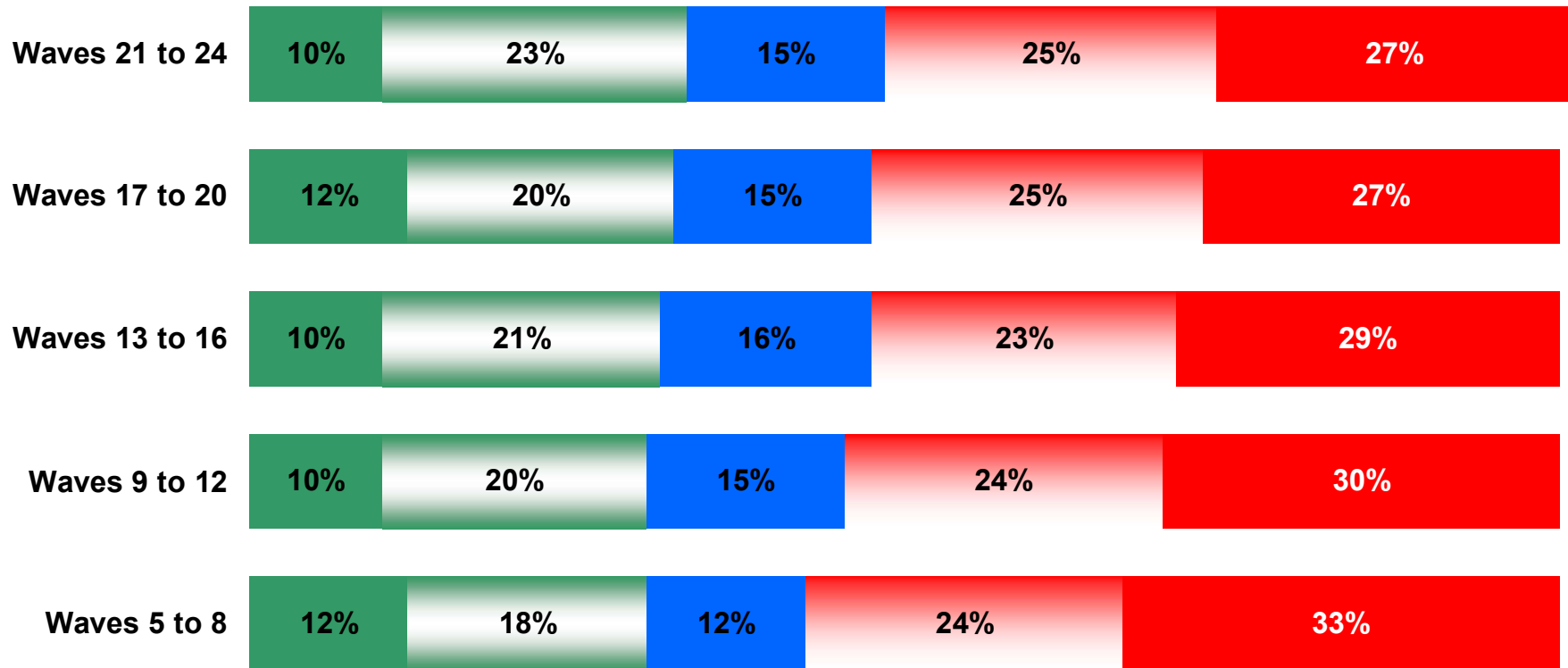




Impact of Recent Events on Canadians Likelihood of Recommending Employment with Canadian Forces (Roll-up)

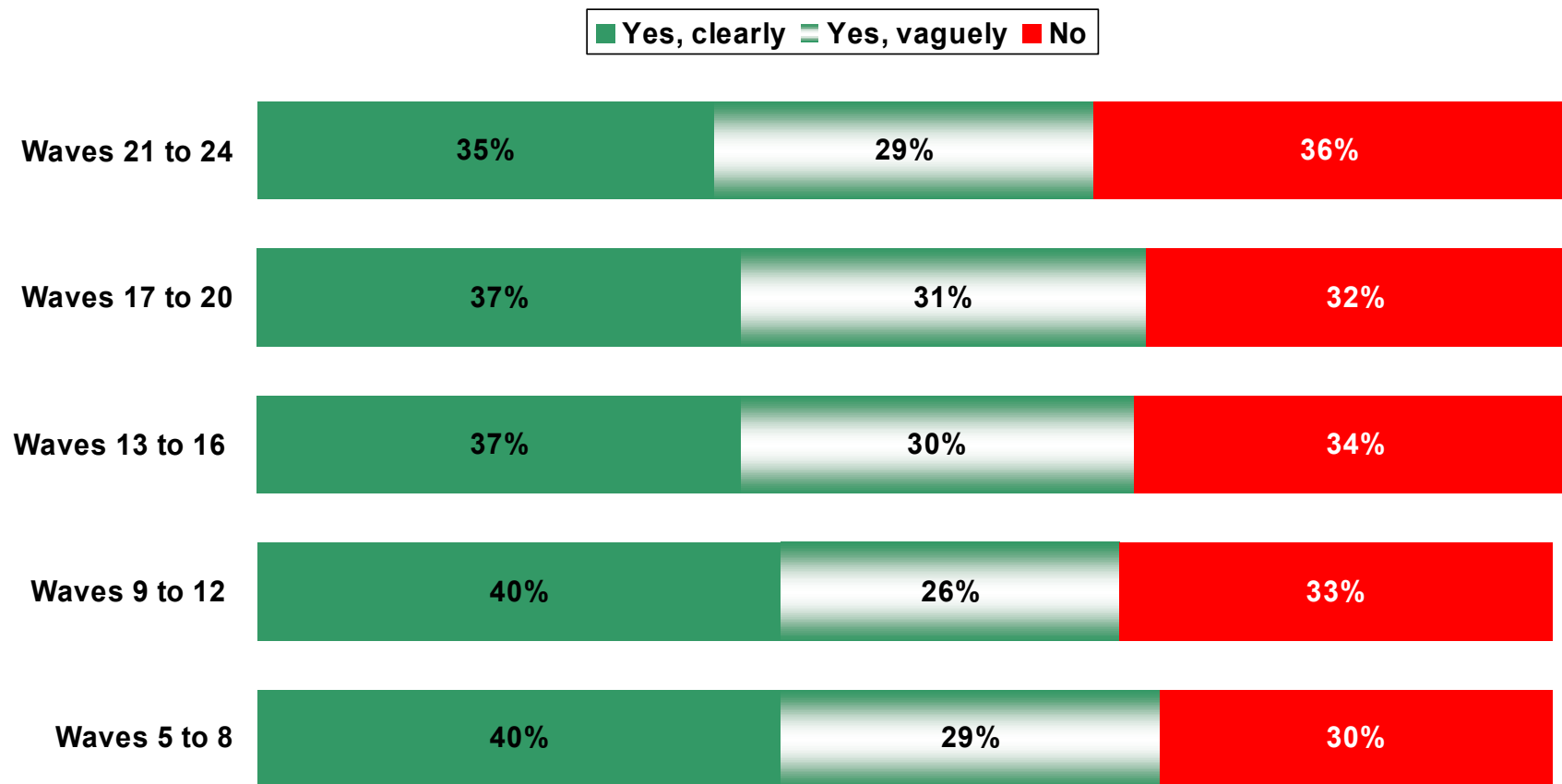

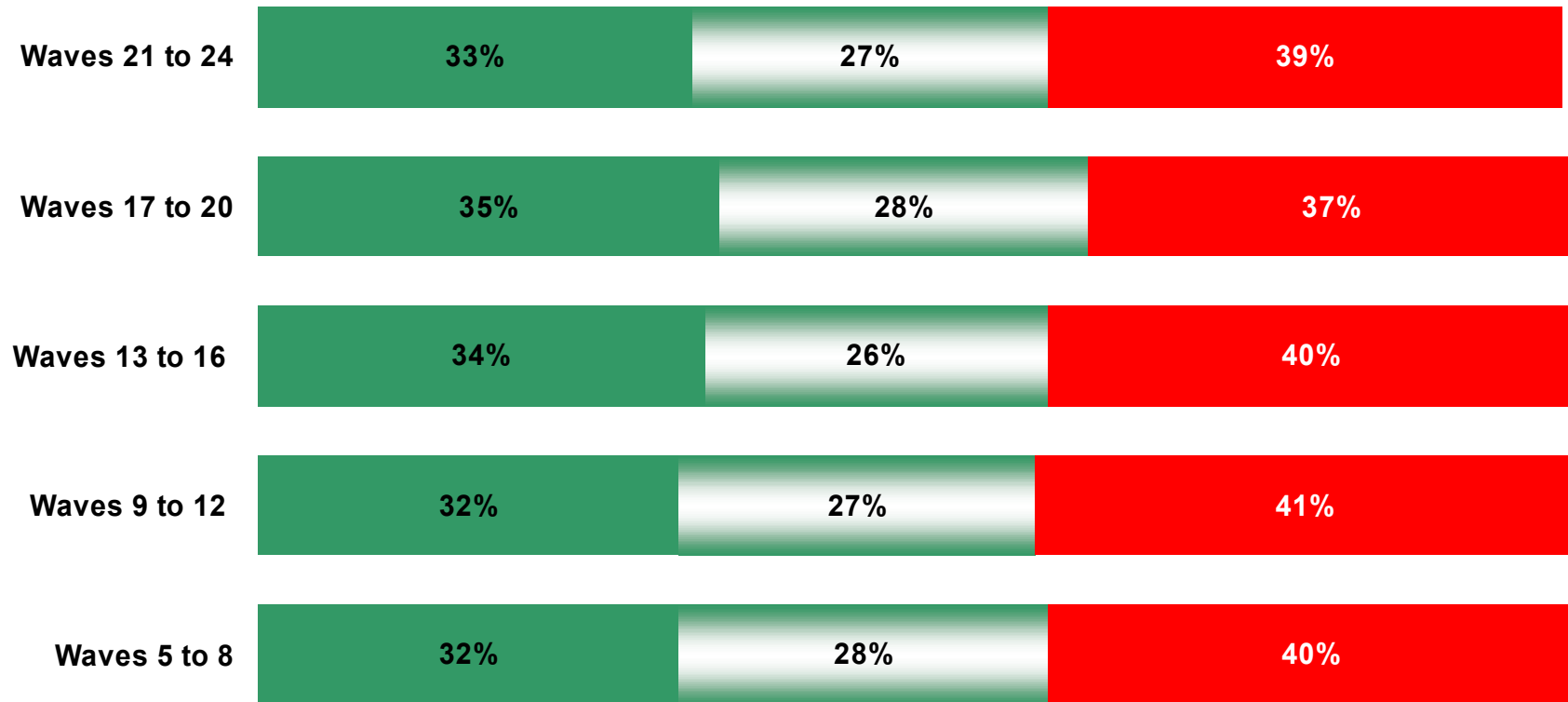

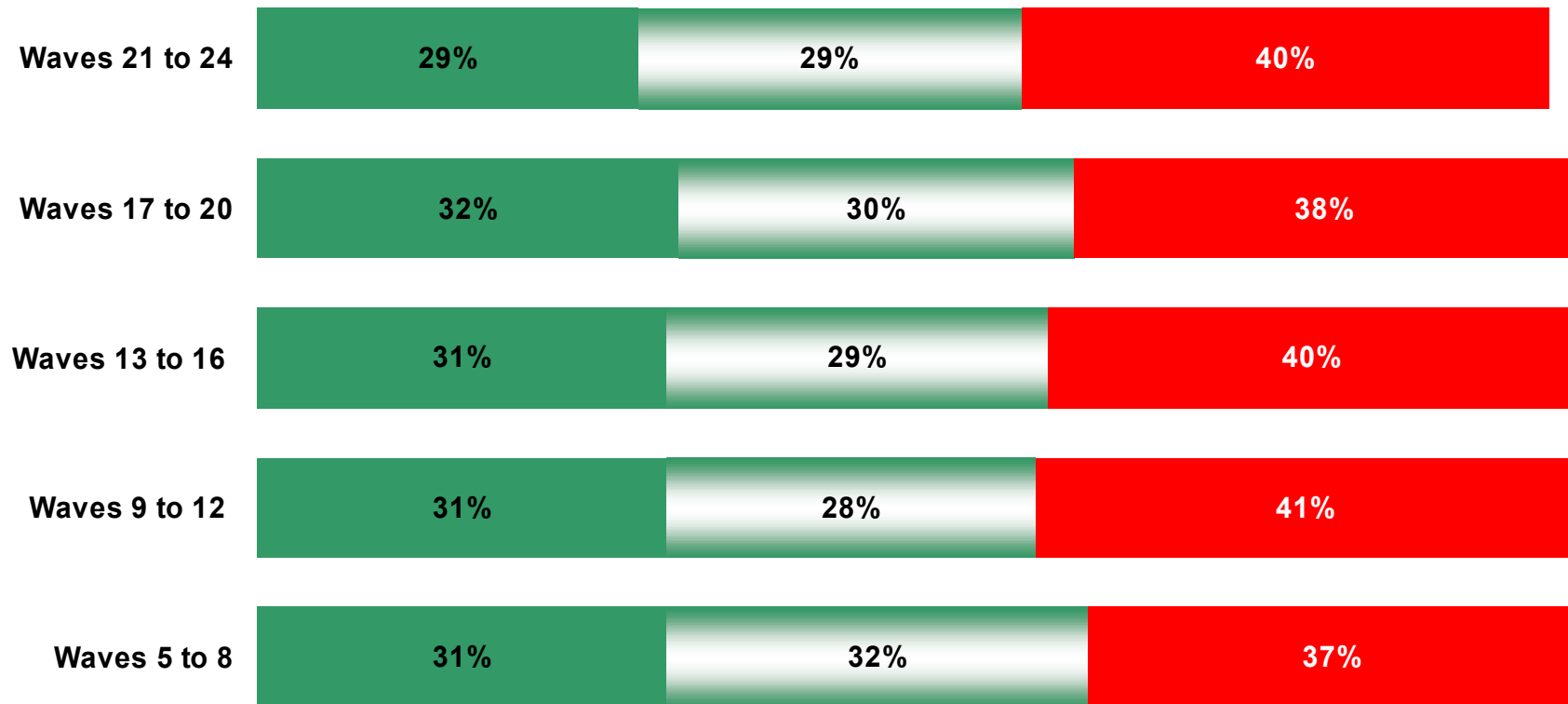

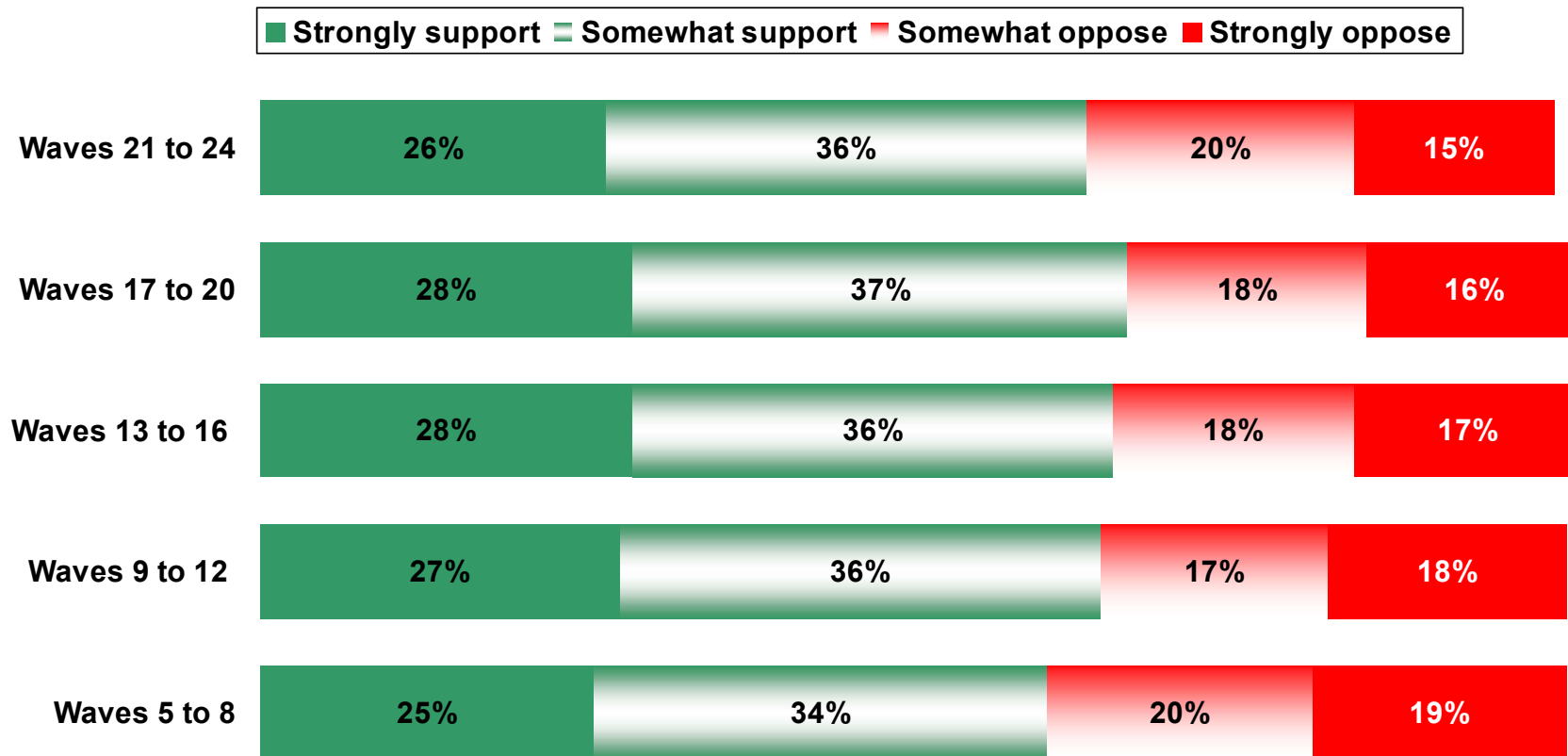

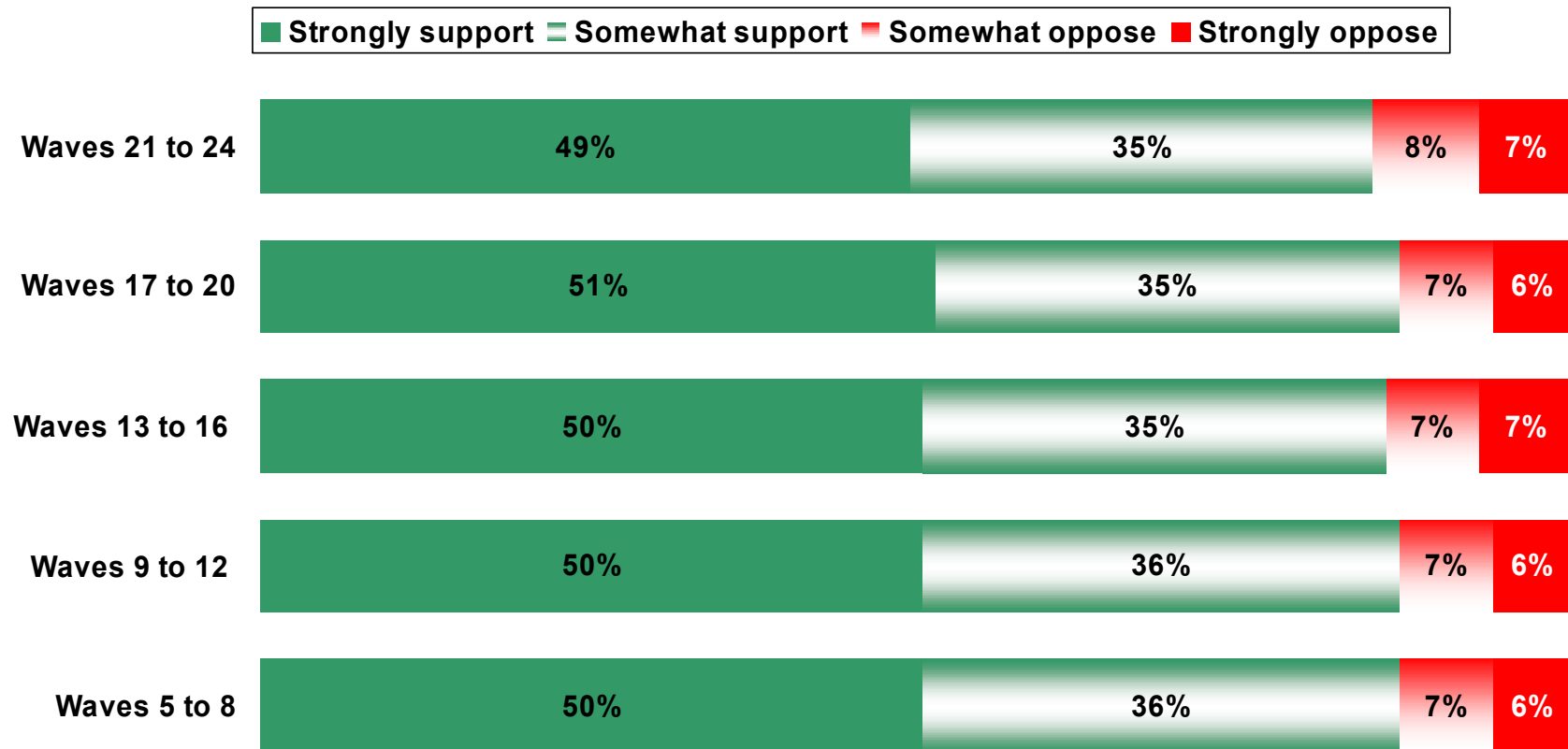

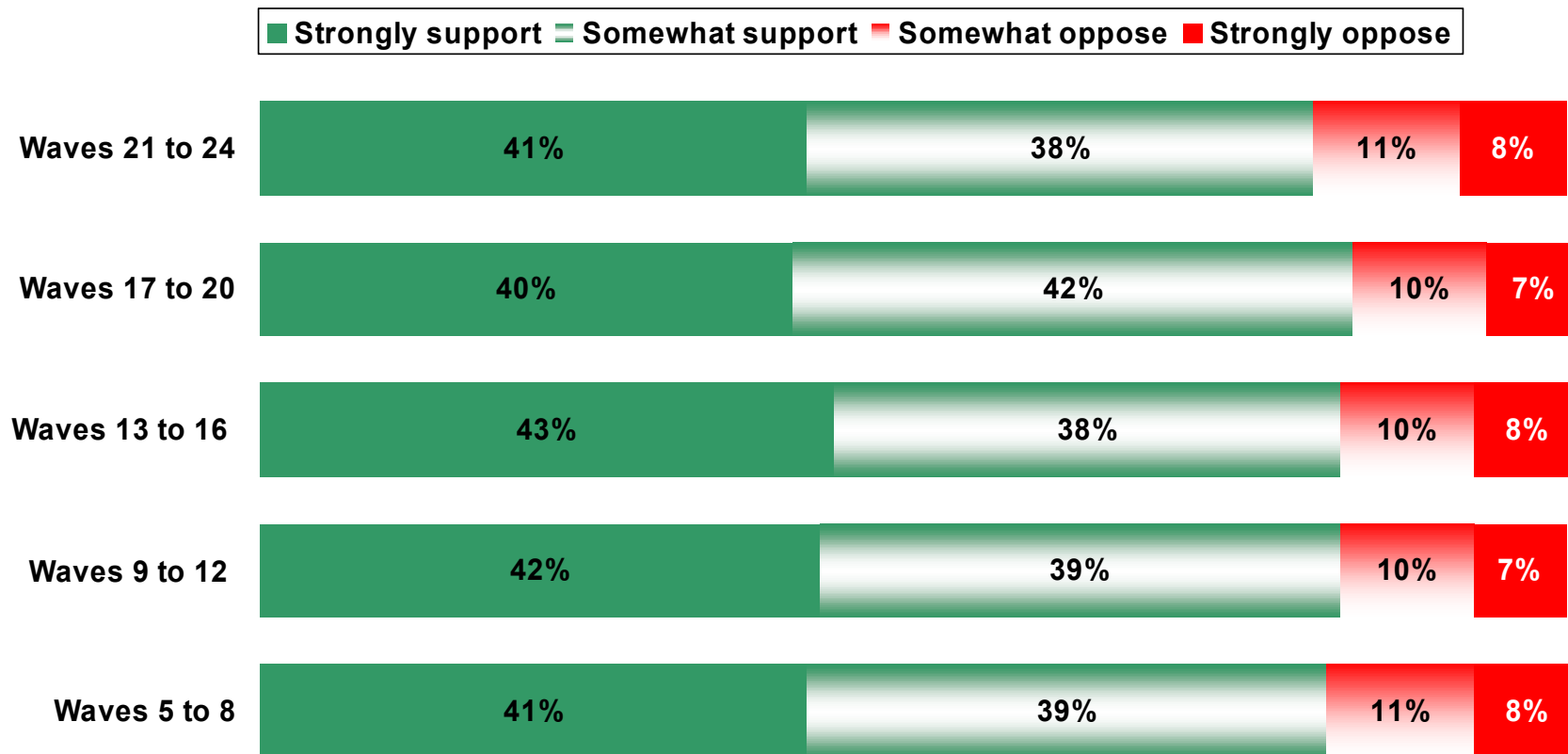

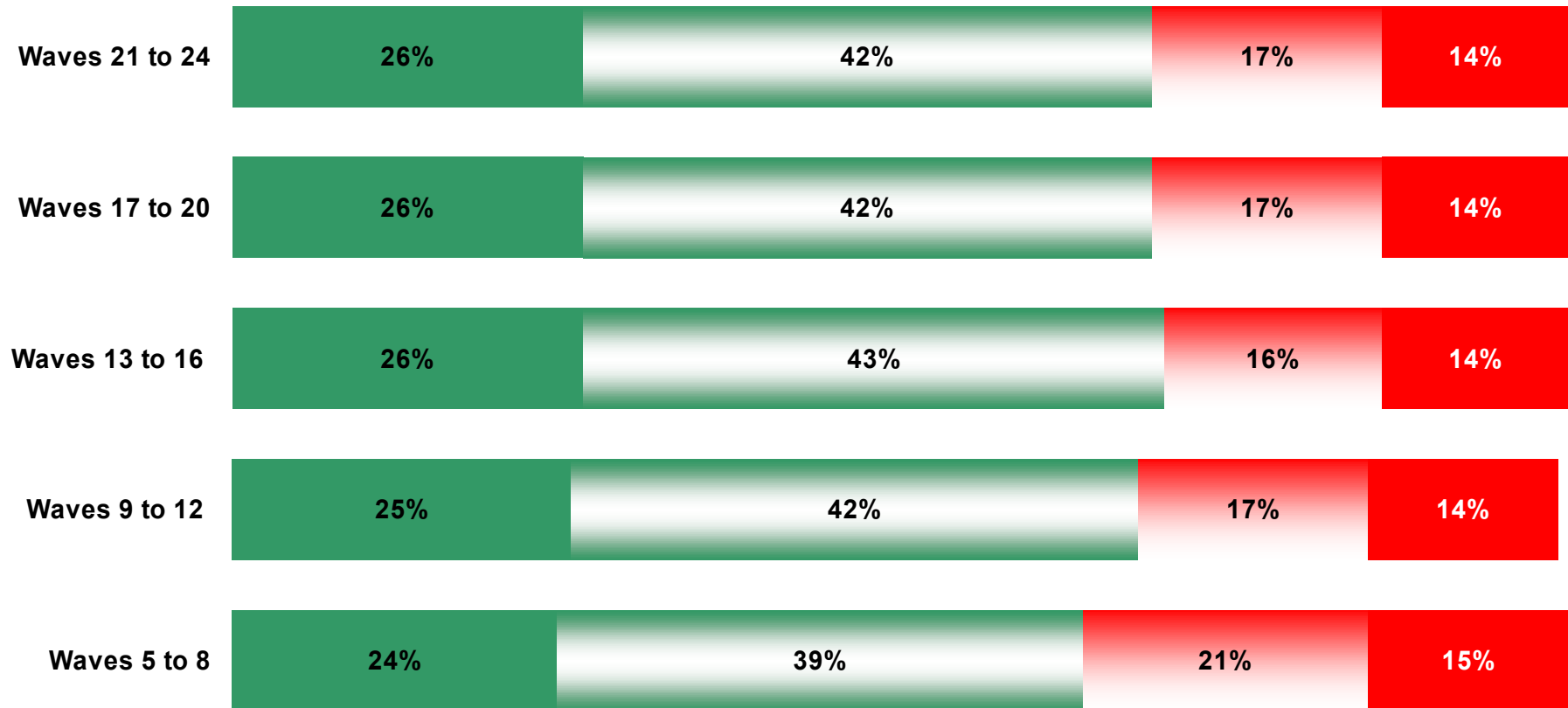

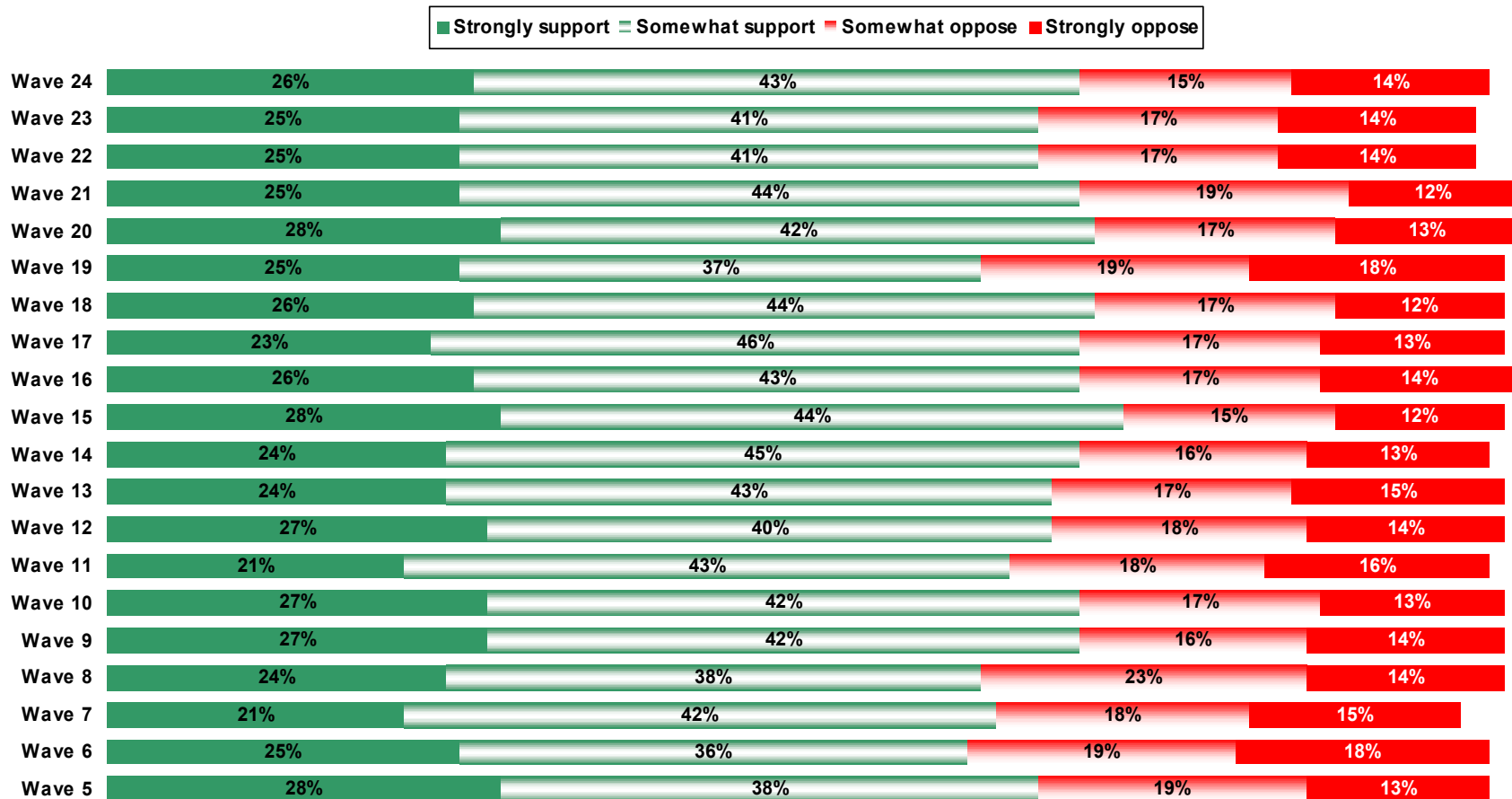

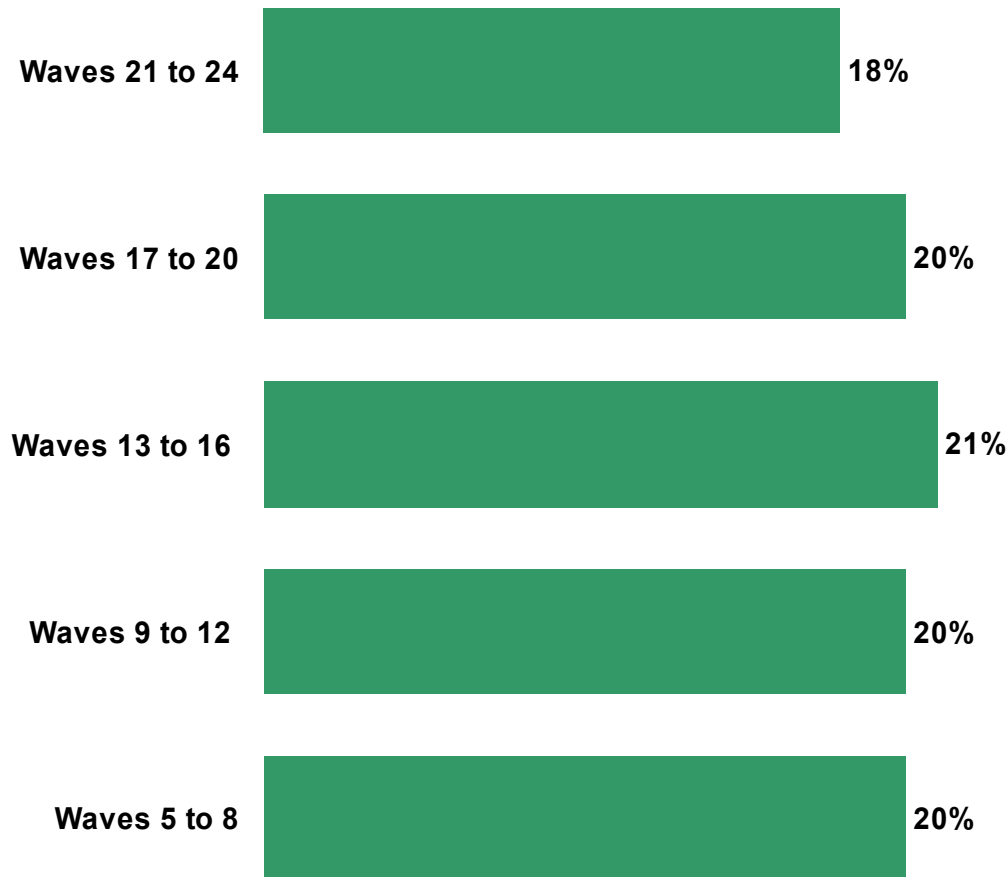

Incidence of Respondent Working/ Family or Friend Working for Canadian Forces (Roll-up)

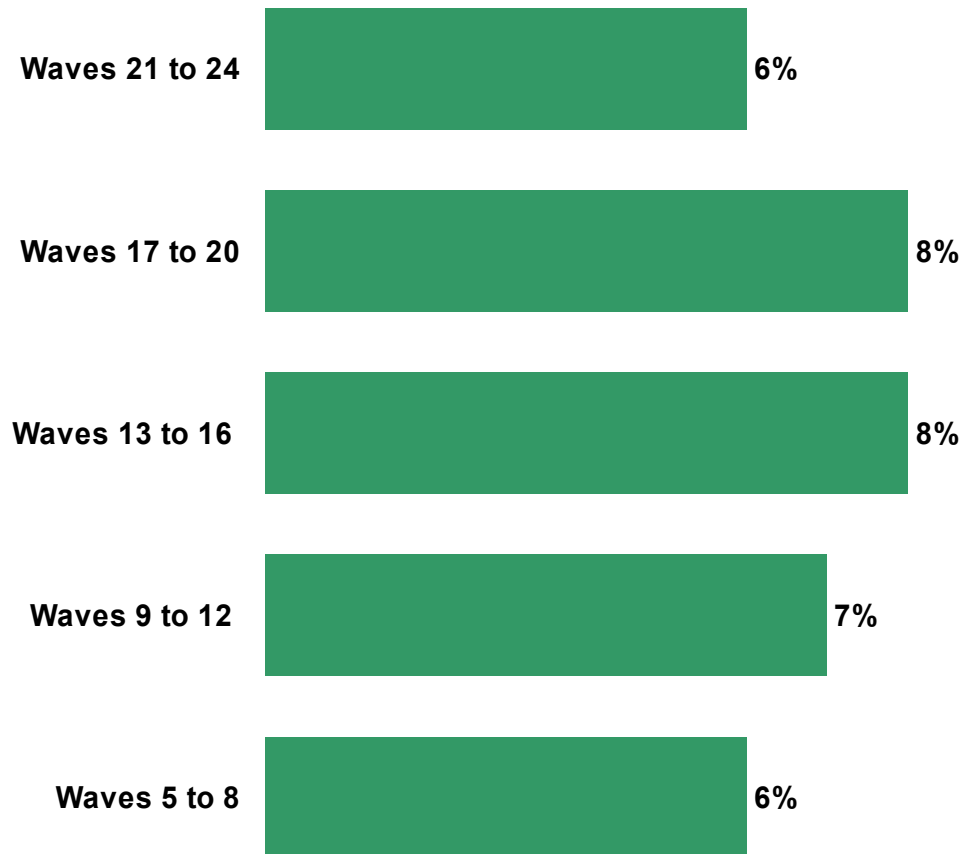

Incidence of Respondent Working for CF (Roll-up)

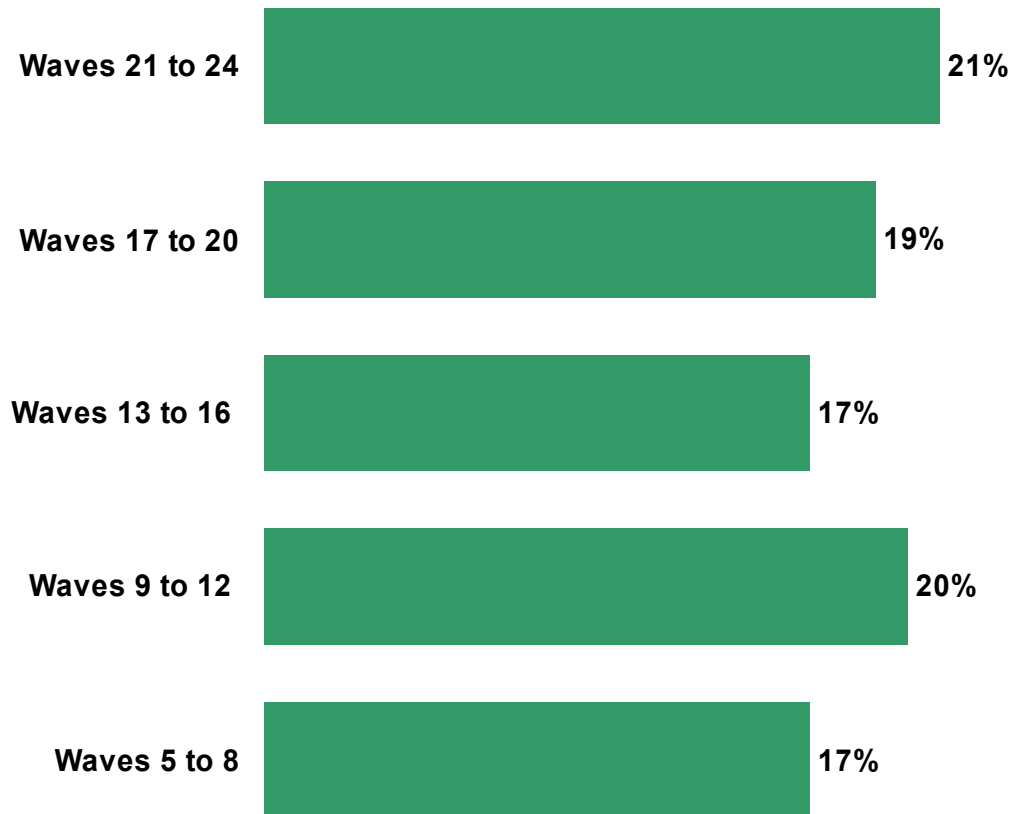
