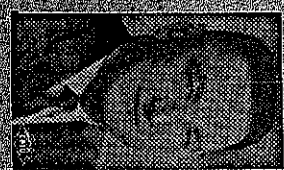


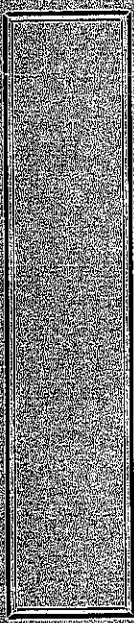

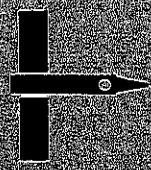

DEVELOPMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES

Manitoba is rich in natural resources. But much of our natural wealth is undeveloped, and some is improperly exploited. The public is not receiving its fair share under present tax concessions and royalty agreements.

ONLY BY ELECTING NEW DEMOCRATS, CAN THE PEOPLE OF MANITOBA:

- bring about the full development of our natural resources
- ensure a fair share from all resource development
- conserve forests and water resources
- improve and expand recreation and vacation facilities
- bring about greater use of the Port of Churchill.

Agriculture

Agriculture is an essential part of Manitoba's economy. Yet farming is full of risks, and the losers are not only the farmers but all Manitobans.

- press for a two-price system for wheat
- establish and help strengthen producer co-operatives and marketing boards
- expand crop-insurance coverage
- guarantee prices for farm products related to the costs of production
- introduce some control over prices
- oppose indiscriminate rail-line abandonment
- press for public ownership of all rail facilities
- help bring about rural home improvements
- extend television service throughout Manitoba

Fishing

A healthy industry benefits the entire province. The fishing industry, however, has seriously declined.

- bring about stable and forward pricing
- increase restocking of fishing areas.

EDUCATION — INVESTMENT IN HUMAN RESOURCES

Education is the best investment we can make. Manitoba can only meet the challenge of the future by raising its educational standards.

But Manitoba has fallen behind other provinces. We are faced with a shortage of good teachers, inadequate and unused facilities, and new, untested courses.

- suitable courses for every child in Manitoba
- special facilities for physically-handicapped, retarded, and emotionally disturbed children
- kindergartens and day nurseries

- community colleges throughout Manitoba, for those who wish to continue their education beyond high school
- improved conditions, to attract and retain good teachers
- an independent department of educational research

EXPANDING OPPORTUNITIES**

Automation is the No. 1 concern of the future. New skills are needed, workers are being displaced, and adjustments are required. In the wrong hands, it means unemployment and confusion. In the right hands, it means prosperity and undreamed-of benefits.
